

SERVICE CONTRACT

This **SERVICE CONTRACT** (the "Contract" or "Service Contract") is entered into and executed by and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF PASIG**, with the official seat of Government at the Pasig City Hall, represented herein by its City Mayor, **HON. VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO**, hereinafter referred to as the "**CITY OF PASIG**";

- and -

EXCELLENT GENERAL SERVICES, INC. a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Philippines, with office address at No. 28 Evangeline Reyes Street, BF Resort Village, Talon II, Las Piñas City, represented herein by its President and General Manager, **GINA O. RAMOS**, and hereinafter referred to as the "**CONTRACTOR**";

Each referred to as a "**PARTY**" and collectively as the "**PARTIES**";

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF PASIG** has a requirement for the Procurement of Provision of Janitorial Services for Various City Owned Hospitals and Facilities under ITB No. bac-23-0127a;

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF PASIG** conducted a public bidding in accordance with Republic Act No. 9184 (Government Procurement Reform Act) and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations on 27 February 2023 for the procurement of the Services;

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR has submitted the single calculated responsive bid for the Services;

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF PASIG** has accepted the bid of **CONTRACTOR**, subject to the terms and conditions hereunder stipulated;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements hereunder specified, the **CITY OF PASIG** and **CONTRACTOR** hereby enter into this Service Contract under the following terms and conditions:

I. SCOPE OF SERVICES

CONTRACTOR shall provide janitorial services and works for the maintenance, sanitation, cleaning, and janitorial works, including all necessary labor, materials, supplies and equipment (hereinafter referred to as "Services"), to the Pasig City General Hospital (PCGH); Pasig City Children's Hospital (PCCH); City Health Department (CHD); and Center for Dialysis, Healthy Lifestyle, Ambulatory Surgery, Maternity and Newborn Care of Pasig City (CHAMP), with full guarantee against unsatisfactory workmanship in accordance with the Terms of Reference included in the bidding documents (a copy of the Terms of Reference is attached and made an integral part hereof as **ANNEX "A"**).

The following documents shall also be deemed to form part of the Service Contract:



- (a) the General Conditions of Contract as contained in the bidding documents (a copy of which is attached and made an integral part hereof as **ANNEX "B"**);
- (b) the Special Conditions of Contract as contained in the bidding documents (a copy of which is attached and made an integral part hereof as **ANNEX "C"**);
- (c) Schedule of Requirements (**ANNEX "D"**)
- (d) Technical Specifications (**ANNEX "E"**)
- (e) Bid Bulletin/s (**ANNEX "F"**)
- (f) The signed technical and financial component of the bid, respectively; and
- (g) other requirements as stated in the bidding documents.

II. NO EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE RELATIONSHIP

1. **CONTRACTOR's** janitors/personnel who shall carry out the Services under this Service Contract are its own employees. There shall be no employer-employee relationship between the **CITY OF PASIG** and the janitors/personnel/employees of **CONTRACTOR**. **CONTRACTOR** shall have the entire charge, control and supervision of the Services herein agreed upon.
2. **CONTRACTOR** shall be responsible for all acts and omissions of its agents, janitors/personnel/employees and all persons allowed by it to have access to the **CITY OF PASIG's** premises, for any death/injury/damage/destruction which may be caused to persons or property while remaining either casually or in business in any part of the **CITY OF PASIG's** premises. Any accident, injury, or sickness of any kind, or death that may occur to any agent, janitor/personnel/employee of **CONTRACTOR**, consequent to the performance of the Services under this Service Contract, shall be the **CONTRACTOR's** sole responsibility. **CONTRACTOR** further binds itself to indemnify and hold the **CITY OF PASIG** free and harmless from any claim on account of the aforementioned injuries or damages.
3. **CONTRACTOR's** janitors/personnel, as its own employees, and not being the employees of the **CITY OF PASIG**, shall not be subject to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the **CITY OF PASIG**. Any offense committed by any of **CONTRACTOR's** janitors/personnel shall constitute a breach of this Service Contract. The **CITY OF PASIG** shall communicate to **CONTRACTOR** all instances of such breach for immediate and appropriate action by **CONTRACTOR**. **CONTRACTOR** shall then inform the **CITY OF PASIG**, in writing, of the action undertaken by **CONTRACTOR**. In case of serious and substantial breach, as determined by the **CITY OF PASIG**, the **CITY OF PASIG** shall require that **CONTRACTOR** take the appropriate steps to address the **CITY OF PASIG's** concerns within the period prescribed by the **CITY OF PASIG**. The inability of **CONTRACTOR** to correct the situation will entitle the **CITY OF PASIG** to impose a corresponding and appropriate penalty against **CONTRACTOR** and/or to rescind this Service Contract.
4. **CONTRACTOR** warrants to comply with its obligations as employer under the Labor Code, its implementing rules, regulations and all other applicable laws and regulations. Non-compliance therewith shall be for its exclusive risk and responsibility and shall constitute a violation of and ground for the termination of this Service Contract

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **CONTRACTOR** warrants that there are no actions, suits or proceedings pending against it or, to the best of its knowledge, threatened, which may have a material adverse effect on its ability to fulfill its obligations under this Contract or on its operations, business, properties, assets or business condition.
2. **CONTRACTOR** shall ensure that its personnel render efficient and effective service. It is understood that the **CITY OF PASIG** shall not evaluate the individual performance of the **CONTRACTOR'S** personnel but **CONTRACTOR'S** service as a whole. Poor performance/late deliveries of supplies/poor maintenance of equipment shall immediately be brought to the attention of **CONTRACTOR** for immediate and appropriate corrective action. **CONTRACTOR** shall then inform the **CITY OF PASIG**, in writing, of the corrective action undertaken.
3. The **CITY OF PASIG** may require replacement of any of the **CONTRACTOR'S** janitor/s who is absent and/or not performing his/her duties and responsibilities to the **CITY OF PASIG'S** satisfaction. In such an eventuality, **CONTRACTOR** shall immediately provide a trained, able, healthy and competent substitute janitor/s acceptable to **CITY OF PASIG**. Should no replacement be provided, the corresponding deduction in the monthly payment shall be made.
4. **CONTRACTOR** shall not unilaterally pull-out any of its personnel without the conformity of the **CITY OF PASIG**.
5. **CONTRACTOR** shall provide the **CITY OF PASIG** with a list of the names of its personnel assigned in the **CITY OF PASIG** and their substitutes immediately from the effectivity date specified in the Notice to Proceed.
6. **CONTRACTOR** shall undertake the training and the random drug-testing of any personnel whenever required by the **CITY OF PASIG**.
7. Subject to the relevant government laws, rules and regulations, the **CITY OF PASIG** may increase or decrease, the number of janitors, or require the rendition of overtime work, depending on the exigencies of the service, in accordance with law and accordingly adjust the monthly payment.
8. At the request of the **CITY OF PASIG**, **CONTRACTOR** shall provide the **CITY OF PASIG** with the duly acknowledged pay slips of its personnel assigned in the **CITY OF PASIG'S** premises and proof of remittance of its/their SSS, Philhealth, ECC and PAG-IBIG contributions relative to the said personnel every month. **THE CITY OF PASIG** reserves the right to require the **CONTRACTOR** to submit clearances from DOLE, SSS, Philhealth, ECC or PAG-IBIG and to check the **CONTRACTOR'S** compliance with labor and social legislations anytime during the contract implementation.
9. In the event that **CONTRACTOR** fails to pay the correct SSS, Philhealth, ECC or PAG-IBIG premiums, the mandated minimum wage, or statutory bonuses, of its janitors assigned in the **CITY OF PASIG'S** premises, the **CITY OF PASIG** shall impose the corresponding penalties and withhold an amount from **CONTRACTOR'S** service fee equal to the premiums and/or salaries/wages/bonuses not paid by **CONTRACTOR**. In addition, **CONTRACTOR'S** failure to pay the correct premiums, wages or bonuses shall also be a ground for the termination of this Service Contract.

10. All claims and disputes relating to or arising out of this Service Contract shall, as much as possible, be settled amicably by the parties before resorting to judicial action.

If the parties fail to settle their differences or disputes, the parties waiving for the purpose any other venue, hereby agree that the courts of the City of Pasig shall be the exclusive venue of any or all actions or suits between the parties, to the exclusion of all other courts and venues. This exclusive venue provision shall apply even if this Service Contract is declared void, in its entirety or in part, and in cases arising after or by reason of the declaration of nullity of this Service Contract in its entirety or in part.

11. This Service Contract and all the rights and interests herein may not be assigned or subcontracted to another without the consent of the other party.

12. The relationship between the parties shall be limited to the performance of the Services as stipulated under this Service Contract. Nothing herein shall be construed to create a general partnership between the parties, or to authorize any party to bind the other, except as set forth in this Service Contract, or to borrow money on behalf of another party, or to use the credit of any party for any purpose.

13. This Service Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties pertaining to the subject matter contained in it and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous contracts, representations, warranties and understandings of the parties. No supplement, variation or amendment to this Service Contract shall be binding unless executed in writing by all the parties thereto.

14. No waiver of any of the provisions of the Service Contract shall be deemed or shall constitute waiver of any provision, whether similar or not similar, nor shall any waiver constitute a continuing waiver. No waiver shall be binding unless in writing and signed by the party making the waiver.

15. In the event that **CONTRACTOR** fails to comply with any of its undertakings, as set forth in this Service Contract, the **CITY OF PASIG** shall be released from its obligations under this Service Contract, without prejudice to its rights of restitution, recovery and damages.

16. **CONTRACTOR** warrants to comply with its obligations as the employer of the janitors under the Service Contract to pay on time the salaries and wages due to its janitors every month. No janitor shall be paid an apprenticeship pay; otherwise, it shall constitute a violation and a ground for the termination of the Service Contract.

17. In case of increase and/or amendments to the present minimum wage and cost of living allowance, Social Security System (SSS) premiums, Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (Philhealth), Employees Compensation Commission (ECC) and Home Development Mutual Fund (HDMF)/ PAG-IBIG, the **CONTRACTOR** shall inform the **CITY OF PASIG** immediately thereof and an amendment to the Contract shall be made upon mutual agreement by both parties.

18. The **CITY OF PASIG** shall also have the right to inspect the employment records of the **CONTRACTOR's** personnel.

19. **CONTRACTOR** shall pay taxes in full and on time, failure to do so will entitle the **CITY OF PASIG** to suspend payment for services rendered by **CONTRACTOR**.

20. **CONTRACTOR** agrees to protect and to exercise due care and proper handling of the properties of the **CITY OF PASIG** during the performance of its work. **CONTRACTOR** and its personnel agree to be jointly and severally liable for any loss, breakage, or destruction of properties as a consequence of their willful intent or negligence in the performance of their obligation damage to the **CITY OF PASIG** through restitution or payment of the same.

21. **CONTRACTOR** shall strictly comply with the requirements of the **CITY OF PASIG** relative to the improvements on the performance of its personnel, delivery of supplies and materials, which shall be in accordance with the prescribed schedule, and the **CITY OF PASIG's** requirement for new and properly maintained equipment. **CONTRACTOR's** failure to comply with the said requirement shall be a ground for the **CITY OF PASIG** to terminate the Service Contract and forfeit the Performance Security.

22. **CONTRACTOR** shall be held liable in case of theft, robbery, or any loss involving its janitor.

23. **CONTRACTOR** hereby holds **THE CITY OF PASIG** free and harmless from any and all actions arising out of the operation and conduct of the janitorial service under the Service Contract, including but without being limited to claims for unpaid wages and back wages, regulation, and other terms and conditions of employment, without prejudice to other civil and criminal liabilities that **CONTRACTOR** may incur as a result of, or arising out of the conduct and pursuit of its janitorial service business and to indemnify the **CITY OF PASIG** from and against the costs of depending any action, suit or proceedings, including legal fees or other expenses incurred in relation to any of such claims mentioned above.


24. **THE CITY OF PASIG** shall release the last payment for the services rendered upon submission of proof of remittance of SSS Premiums, Philhealth, PAG-IBIG and, if applicable, upon proof of the release of the cash bond of the janitors.



25. It is understood that all terms and conditions provided in the Bidding Documents shall form an integral part of the contract.

IV. CONTRACTUAL PERIOD

1. This Service Contract shall be effective for a period of two (2) years commencing on the effectivity date provided in the Notice to Proceed; however, **CONTRACTOR's** renewal for the second year shall be conditioned upon the satisfactory performance of **CONTRACTOR** upon assessment or evaluation of the **CITY OF PASIG** and the submission by the supplier of updated "Class A" eligibility documents and performance security. Thus, before the end of the first year, the **CITY OF PASIG** shall conduct an assessment or evaluation of the performance of **CONTRACTOR** based on the criteria in the Terms of Reference and the bidding documents. Based on such assessment, the **CITY OF PASIG** may either renew the Service Contract for the additional one (1) year or pre-terminate the contract for failure by **CONTRACTOR** to perform its obligations thereon following the procedure



prescribed under the Guidelines on Termination of Contracts in the IRR of R.A. No. 9184.

2. **THE CITY OF PASIG** may terminate the Service Contract, with or without cause, without incurring any liability whatsoever, without the need of judicial intervention, upon thirty (30) days written notice to **CONTRACTOR**.
3. Should **CONTRACTOR** incur delay in the performance of the Services, **CONTRACTOR** shall pay a penalty of one-tenth of one percent (1/10 of 1%) of the total cost of the unperformed portion for each day of delay, including Sundays and Holidays, beyond the specific period. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the Contract Price of the Service Contract. Once the cumulative maximum deduction reaches ten percent (10%) of the Contract Price, the **CITY OF PASIG** shall have the option to rescind the Service Contract without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies to open it.
4. In case **CONTRACTOR** still fails to deliver the Services after the lapse of fifteen (15) days, the **CITY OF PASIG** shall have the option to terminate this Service Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open it to.


V. CONTRACT AND SCHEDULE OF PAYMENTS

1. Contract Price for the Services shall be in the following amount/s which shall be inclusive of applicable taxes and subjected to the mandated withholding tax. The breakdown of price schedule is attached as "Annex G"

The above service fee shall be paid by the **CITY OF PASIG** within forty-five (45) calendar days from receipt of **CONTRACTOR's** billing every 15th and 30th (or 31st) of the month.

Payment shall be made according to the actual deployed number of **CONTRACTOR's** janitors.

No janitor shall be paid an apprenticeship pay or a salary below the minimum wage.

3. Night Shift Differential and Holiday Pay, which may be allowed under the Labor Code, shall be computed separately, in accordance with law, and shall be for the account of **CONTRACTOR**. Deductions shall be made from **CONTRACTOR's** billings based on **CONTRACTOR's** personnel's absences.
4. The Contract Price already includes all applicable taxes, fees and charges required by the government. **CONTRACTOR** holds the **CITY OF PASIG** free from liability for any or all taxes and government fees and charges arising out of this Service Contract.
5. The Contract Price shall not subject to any increase or upward adjustment for any reason or cause whatsoever for the duration of the Service Contract, except as provided for under the Contract.
6. **CONTRACTOR** shall inform the **CITY OF PASIG** and prepare a Supplemental Schedule of Payment and the corresponding additional or replacement Performance Security, as necessary, in case of an increase in the present minimum wage, cost of living allowance, SSS, Philhealth, ECC and PAG-IBIG premiums and all other similar increases, after the signing of this Service Contract, by subsequent government decrees or orders and submit the same to the **CITY OF PASIG** together with a copy of the government decree or order mandating the increase.

Upon the **CITY OF PASIG's** verification of the conformity to the Supplemental Schedule of Payment, additional or replacement Performance Security, if any, and the government decree or order mandating the increase, the Supplemental Schedule of Payment shall form part of the Service Contract as an amendment thereto.

VI. CLEARANCES, PERMITS, LICENSES and TAXES

1. **CONTRACTOR** warrants that it is an entity duly organized, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines and that it is duly registered and capable and has the requisite, power, authority, permits, clearances and licenses, to enter into this Service Contract and to perform the Services and all of its obligations under this Service Contract.
2. All amounts, claims, and expenses pertaining to clearances, licenses, permits, registrations or renewals thereof required by the **CITY OF PASIG** or the appropriate government entities for the Services to be performed under this Service Contract shall be for the exclusive account of **CONTRACTOR**.

3. **CONTRACTOR** shall provide the **CITY OF PASIG**, whenever required by the latter, with the Philippine National Police, National Bureau of Investigation, health or any other government clearance of all its personnel assigned in the **CITY OF PASIG**.
4. **CONTRACTOR** shall pay its taxes in full and on time. Its failure to do so shall entitle the **CITY OF PASIG** to suspend payment for services rendered by **CONTRACTOR**. **CONTRACTOR** shall regularly present a tax clearance from the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) and a copy of its income and business tax returns, duly stamped, received and validated by the BIR, indicating the tax payments made thereon.
5. The **CITY OF PASIG** reserves the right to require the submission of clearance from the DOLE, NLRC, SSS, Philhealth, or PAG-IBIG anytime during contract implementation to ensure continuing compliance with the labor laws and other social legislation.

VII. PERFORMANCE SECURITY

CONTRACTOR shall post a Performance Surety (the "Security"), for the benefit of the **CITY OF PASIG**, conditioned on the former's compliance with all of its obligations under this Service Contract, within ten (10) calendar days from the receipt of Notice to Award and in no case later than the signing of the Service Contract, in accordance with any of the following schedule:



The Performance Security shall remain valid until the issuance of the final Certificate of Acceptance. It may be released only after the issuance of the final Certificate of Acceptance of the Services, provided that there are no claims filed against **CONTRACTOR** or the surety company.

VIII. INDEMNIFICATION

1. **CONTRACTOR** hereby holds the **CITY OF PASIG**, its officers, employees and agents free and harmless from any and all actions or liabilities arising out of this Service Contract, including, without being limited to, claims for unpaid and back wages, regularization, and other terms and conditions of employment, as well as civil and criminal liabilities that **CONTRACTOR** and/or the **CITY OF PASIG** may incur as a result of, or arising out of, the conduct and/or pursuit of Services and to indemnify the **CITY OF PASIG** from and against the costs of defending any action, suit or proceedings, including legal fees or other expenses incurred in relation to any such claims mentioned above.




2. **CONTRACTOR** agrees to protect and to exercise due care and proper handling of the properties of the **CITY OF PASIG** during the performance of the Services. **CONTRACTOR** shall be jointly and severally liable with its janitors/personnel and shall indemnify and hold the **CITY OF PASIG** free and harmless for any death, injury or damage to the **CITY OF PASIG** and to third persons for loss, breakage, or destruction of properties, as a consequence of **CONTRACTOR's** acts or omissions, willful intent or negligence, during the performance of the Services or its obligations under this Service Contract.


3. **CONTRACTOR** shall be liable in case of theft, robbery or any loss within the **CITY OF PASIG's** premises serviced by **CONTRACTOR's** janitors/personnel. **CONTRACTOR** hereby agrees to replace, repair or reconstitute any loss involving its janitors/personnel.

IX. CONFIDENTIALITY

1. All information disclosed to **CONTRACTOR**, its directors, officers, employees, personnel, agents, and other persons acting on **CONTRACTOR's** behalf, arising out of or as a result of this Service Contract shall be confidential in nature and shall remain as the **CITY OF PASIG's** property and shall be used only for the purposes specifically related to this Service Contract. **CONTRACTOR**, its officers, employees, personnel, agents, or any other persons acting on its behalf, shall not, at any time, disclose such confidential information to any third party without the **CITY OF PASIG's** prior written consent.

2. In the event that **CONTRACTOR**, its directors, officers, employees, personnel, agents and other persons acting on **CONTRACTOR's** behalf, is required by law to disclose any information known to **CONTRACTOR** as a result of this Service Contract, **CONTRACTOR** will provide the **CITY OF PASIG** with prompt prior written notice of such requirement so that the **CITY OF PASIG** may seek an appropriate protective order / measure. In the event that the **CITY OF PASIG** fails to secure the appropriate order / measure, **CONTRACTOR**, its directors, officers, employees, personnel, agents, and other persons acting on **CONTRACTOR's** behalf, shall disclose only the portion of the Confidential Information that it is legally compelled to disclose.

3.  Any breach of any of the provisions on confidentiality by any of **CONTRACTOR's** officers, employees, personnel, agents, or any other person acting on its behalf, shall render **CONTRACTOR** solidarily liable to the **CITY OF PASIG** for damages, without prejudice to the civil and criminal actions against **CONTRACTOR**, its officers employees, personnel, agents, and other person/s acting on its behalf. **CONTRACTOR** shall also be liable for costs and expenses incurred by the **CITY OF PASIG** in connection with the enforcement of provisions of this Confidentiality Clause.

4.  **CONTRACTOR** acknowledges and agrees that monetary damages would not be a sufficient remedy for any breach of this Confidentiality Clause by **CONTRACTOR**, its directors, officers, employees, personnel, agents and other persons acting on **CONTRACTOR's** behalf, and that the **CITY OF PASIG** shall be entitled to specific performance, including injunctive relief, as a remedy for any such breach. Such remedy shall not be deemed to be the exclusive remedy for breach of this Confidentiality Clause but shall be in addition to all other remedies available in law or equity. **CONTRACTOR**

agrees to reimburse the **CITY OF PASIG** for all costs and expenses, including, without limitation, attorney's fees, incurred by the **CITY OF PASIG** in connection with the enforcement of this Confidentiality Clause.
