PROCUREMENT OF A LEARNING SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE CONDUCT OF EMERGENCY TELECOMMUNICATOR (ETC) CERTIFICATION COURSE

BACKGROUND OF THE PROJECT II.

EMERGENCY TELECOMMUNICATOR (ETC) Certification Course is a 40-hour program produced by the International Academies of Emergency Dispatch or IAED and is designed to train employees unfamiliar with emergency communication centers, emergency telecommunication technology, interpersonal communication, legal issues and job stress factors.

Pasig DRRMO as mandated by law under RA 10121 is the main line of defense of the City when it comes to disaster management and response. In order to ensure up to date knowledge on various system operations, Pasig City DRRMO will conduct Standard Basic Training in Emergency TeleCommunicator.

At the end of the training, the participants will be able to:

- 1. Develop a better understanding on Emergency TeleCommunications Technologies;
- 2. Perform Call Management and determine Call Classification (Police, Fire and Medical);
