TERMS OF REFERENCE

A. PROCUREMENT TITLE

PROCUREMENT OF A LEARNING SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE CONDUCT OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN WITH BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (EMT-B) TRAINING FOR TWENTY (20) PASIG CITY DRRMO PERSONNEL

B. BACKGROUND

Pasig City DRRMO has nurses and college graduates that are tasked as responders in emergency response. Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) is a training course that provides in-depth knowledge and skills to care for sick and injured people who need emergency medical treatment. This is a high-stakes certification course that requires professionals to act quickly and accurately, thinking on their feet as care for patients in chaotic situations. EMT-B Training is also one of the requirements of DOH Accreditation for Advance Cardiac Life Support Ambulances.

C. OBJECTIVES

At the end of the training, the selected participants will be able to:

- Describe the essential elements for the safe and efficient response to the scene of a medical emergency.
- Perform a thorough EMS patient assessment for signs and symptoms of illnesses and injuries.
- Provide prompt and efficient basic emergency care to the sick and injured.
- Safely handle and prepare the patient for transportation.
- Apply fundamental knowledge of the EMS system, safety and well-being of the EMT, Medical, Legal, and Ethical issues to the provision of emergency care.

- Any changes / adjustment in training schedules, the Training Division and the Training provider, will coordinate and meet halfway for the finality of the re-scheduling dates of the said Training.
