Series of 2004

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PASIG CITY SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL TO BE FUNDED BY THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD AND THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, this policy is specifically enunciated in the National Government's overall pole vaulting development strategy, identifying Science and Technology as one major areas of concern and challenge to national and local development;

WHEREAS, it is also an avowed mandate of the City Government to pursue programs that will address the overall "human index" development of the City constituency, possibly offering scholastic, in-plant and extension Science & Technology formal schooling and industrial and extension trainings to enhance our expertise in this knowledge and skills sector.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Pasig in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1 - A SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL is hereby established in Pasig City to be known as Pasig City Science High School.

SECTION 2 - SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL shall primarily provide higher academic, training in applied research and advance studies.

SECTION 3 - VISION AND MISSION. The Pasig City Science High School is established as an institution envisioned to become direct, capable collaborator of the City Government in conceptualizing and implementing Science & Technology sectoral development program for the City. The institution's mission is to virtually serve as a direct source/supplier of competent and well-trained Science & Technology entrepreneurs, professionals and skilled manpower to service the City's development requirements.

SECTION 4 - The governing body of the Pasig City Science High School shall be composed of the principal, the head teachers of each subject area, and the administrative officer, who will be appointed by the City Mayor upon recommendation of the Schools Division Superintendent and/or the Regional Director.

SECTION 5 - The body of teachers shall constitute the faculty of Pasig City Science High School. Initial members of the faculty is thirty six (36). Breakdown is as follows:

SECTION 6 - The Heads of Departments of the Pasig City Hall and the officers of the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Pasig are hereby authorized to loan or transfer, upon request of the Principal of Pasig City Science High School, such apparatus, equipment, supplies or the services of such employees and faculty members who can be spared without serious detriment to public service. The employees so detailed shall perform such duty as required of them under such detail and the time so employed shall be counted as part of their regular official service.

SECTION 7 - FUNDING AND APPROPRIATIONS. Funding for the establishment of the Pasig City Science High School will be taken from the General Fund of the City Government and from the Local School Board.

Funds for the salaries of the school principal, faculty, and non-teaching personnel will be taken from the General Fund of the City Government


Students of the school will receive the amount of Two Hundred Pesos (Php200.00) and the teachers Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00) each as monthly allowance which will be appropriated from the Local School Board.


SECTION 8 - MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS. An efficient management and operations set-up will be installed, including the hiring of non-teaching personnel, to enable the successful institution build-up of the school. An Ad Hoc Committee, headed by the Consultant on Education, will be immediately formed to set-up the initial management and operations guidelines of the school within thirty (30) days upon approval of this ordinance.

SECTION 9 - QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION. Residents of Pasig City, especially those coming from the marginalized sector shall be given priority in the admission of students.


SECTION 10 - EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.








An Ordinance establishing the Pasig City Science High School to be funded by the Local School Board and the General Fund of the City Government.




