ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE "TAGAMASID NG PASIG" PROJECT AS AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE ANTI-ILLEGAL DRUGS CAMPAIGN OF THE CITY, DEFINING THE COMPONENTS AND REWARDS SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the drug situation in Pasig City has always been a cause of peace, security and overall development concerns in spite of the efforts conducted by different agencies of the city government;

WHEREAS, there are indications that the remaining 1.45 tons of high-grade cocaine of the 1.9 tons dumped by a foreign-owned vessel off the coast of Samar province on December 29, 2009 are now being peddled in the streets of Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, the city government takes cognizance of the escalation of the drug problem that has been proving to be a menace and a grave social problem victimizing not only the youth but people from all ages and economic classes.

WHEREAS, the problem requires innovative and focused intervention efforts and in response to this the city government is establishing this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session duly assembled hereby enact:

SECTION 1. Purpose – This ordinance aims to establish, define the components and the reward system as well as the procedures required by the Tagamasid ng Pasig project.

SECTION 2. Definitions – For the purposes of this ordinance, the following terms are thus defined below:

Tagamasid or informant – person(s) who have information on people, laboratories, drug den, farms or storage areas that deal with illegal drugs and their components, derivatives and products and are willing to report such information to the Tagamasid ng Pasig Project (TPP).

Dangerous Drugs – include those listed in the Schedules annexed to the 1961 Single Convention on Narcotics Drugs, as amended by the 1972 protocol, and in the Schedules annexed to the 1971 Single Convention of Psychotropic Substances.

Shabu – common name for Methamphetamine Hydrochloride, refers to the drug having such chemical composition, including any of its isomer or derivative in any form. Other common names are 'ice', 'meth'.

Cocaine - a crystalline alkaloid that is obtained from the leaves of the coca plant that acts as a stimulant of the central nervous system and an appetite suppressant.

Ecstasy – common name for Methylenedioxymethamphetamin (MDMA) – refers to the drug having such chemical compositions including any of its isomers or derivative in any form.

Marijuana – common name for Cannabis – embraces every kind, class, genus or specie of the plant Cannabis sativa L. Including but not limited to Cannabis Americana, hashis, bhang, guaza, churrus and ganjab, and embraces every kind, class and character of marijuana, whether dried or fresh and flowering, flowering or fruiting tops or any part or portion of the plant and seeds thereof, and all its geographic varieties, whether as a reefer, resin, extract, tincture or in any form whatsoever.

Hashish (more commonly called hash) is a potent form of cannabis produced by collecting and processing the most potent material that female marijuana plants naturally generate as part of their growth cycle.

Pusher – any person who sells, trades, administers, dispenses, delivers or gives away to another, on any terms whatsoever, or distributes, dispatches in transit or transports dangerous drugs or who acts as broker in any of such transactions, in violation of Republic Act 9165.

Clandestine Laboratory - any facility used for the illegal manufacture of any dangerous drug and/or controlled precursor and essential chemical.

SECTION 3. Coverage – The pushers, drug dens, farms, storage and laboratories to be reported must be within the territorial jurisdiction of Pasig City.

SECTION 4. Rewards System – A system of rewards to be granted to the Tagamasid consists of a schedule of rewards based on the type and quantity/capacity of confiscated drugs or dismantled laboratories. The following specifies the rewards:

A. Confiscated/Recovered Shabu/Cocaine

Less than 0.5 gram	P1,000.00
0.5-0.9 grams	P1,500 + P100/0.1gram in excess of 0.5 gram
1.0-1.4 grams	P2,000 + P100/0.1gram in excess of 1.0 gram
1.5 -499 grams	P2,500 + P100/gram in excess of 1.5 grams
500-999 grams	P52,500 + P100/gram in excess of 500 grams
1 kg-2 kgs	P102,400 + P50/gram in excess of 1 kilogram
2.1-5 kgs	P152,500 + P40/gram in excess of 2.1 kilograms
5.1-10 kgs	P268,700 + P30/gram in excess of 5.1 kilograms
10.1 -20 kgs	P415,800 + P20/gram in excess of 10.1 kilograms
20.1-50 kgs	P613,900 + P10/gram in excess of 20.1 kilograms
50.1-100 kgs	P913,000 + P5/gram in excess of 50.1 kilograms
More than 100 kgs	P1,200,000 + P2,500/ gram in excess of 100 kilograms

B. Confiscated/Recovered Ecstasy Tablets (MDMA)

Less than 13 tablets	P80/tablet
13-250 tablets	P100/tablet
251-650 tablets	P25,100 + P60/tab in excess of 251 tablets
651-1,350 tablets	P49,100 + P50/tab in excess of 651 tablets
1,351-2,500 tablets	P99,100+P40/tab in excess of 1,351 tablets
2,501-6,700 tablets	P145,100+P30/tab in excess of 2,501 tablets
6,701-25,000 tablets	P271,100 + P20/tab in excess of 6,701 tablets
25,001-67,500 tablets	P638,000 + P10/tab in excess of 25,001 tablets
67,501-135,000 tablets	P1,063,000 + P5/tab in excess of 67,501 tablets
135,001-275,000 tabs	P1,400,500 + P2500/1350 tabs in excess of 135,001 tablets
275,001-650,000 tabs	P1,659,800 + P2000/1350 tabs in excess of 276,001 tablets
More than 651,000 tabs	P2,200,000

C. Confiscated/Recovered Marijuana, Hashish, Seeds

10% of the value of the confiscated or recovered crops and its derivatives up to a maximum of P500,000.00 shall be given to the Tagamasid/informants who gave information provided that the cultivator/planter is arrested.

D. Confiscated/Recovered Diverted Products

10% of the current local market value as determined by the Dangerous Drugs Board up to a maximum of P500,000.00 shall be given a reward when Ephedrine, Acethylantranilic Acid, Ergometrine, Laosofrole, Lysergic Acid, 3,4-methelenedioxyphenil-2-propanone, 1-phenyl-2-propane, Piperonal, Safrole are confiscated, provided the owner/peddler of the chemicals is arrested.

E. Dismantling of Clandestine Laboratories

For purposes of this project, clandestine laboratories are classified according to size of production as follows and as certified by the Dangerous Drugs Board assigned crime laboratory for the purpose:

1. **Small Laboratory** (with production capacity of less than 10 kgs/batch) P500,000 + computed reward under Republic 9165, Section 11, paras a,b,c.
2. **Medium Laboratory** (with production capacity of 10 - 50 kgs/batch) P1,000,000 + computed reward under R.A. 9165, Section 11, paras a,b,c.
3. **Large Laboratory** (with production capacity of more than 50 kgs/batch) P1,500,000 + computed reward under R.A. 9165, Section 11, paras a,b,c.

SECTION 5. Eligibility. Anyone (except members of PDEA, DDB, PNP, NBI or any government agency exercising enforcement function including their relatives up to 4th degree of consanguinity and affinity) who can provide information that shall result in the confiscation, recovery or destruction of dangerous drugs, precursor chemicals, clandestine laboratories for illegal drugs, and marijuana plantations, including the arrest of pushers are eligible to become informants or *Tagamasid* in this program. They are entitled to receive commensurate rewards in accordance to the Schedule of Rewards under Section 5 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. Procedure. A potential *Tagamasid*/Informant shall fill up an Information Reporting Form (IRF) which he/she will submit (thru fax or email or in person) to the person-in-charge at the Anti-Drug Abuse Council of Pasig (ADCOP) who, in turn, will give him/her a Code Name for the purpose of the project. Follow-up on action made and results concerning the submitted reports can be made through the phone, fax, email or in person using the *Tagamasid*/informant's assigned Code Name.

Rewards are given upon confirmation of the confiscation/recovery or destruction as the case may be and a case has been filed against the pusher, planter or owner. The filing of the City Prosecutor or any appropriate legal officer of the proper case in the trial court shall authorize the grant of the reward.

SECTION 7. Implementation Scheme. For the purpose of this Ordinance, an appropriate Information Reporting Form will be widely disseminated in Pasig City together with announcement flyers for the Tagamasid ng Pasig Project.

The Anti-Drug Abuse Council of Pasig under the Office of the Mayor will serve as the secretariat of the program assisted by the Legal Office and the Finance Unit of the Pasig City Government.

SECTION 8. Reporting. ADCOP shall be submitting a quarterly report on the performance and accomplishments of the project to the Office of the City Mayor and the Sangguniang Panlungsod through the Committee on Minors and Drug Prevention.

SECTION 9. Appropriation. There shall be an appropriation of THREE MILLION PESOS (P3,000,000.00) for the first year of implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, fund allocation and appropriate publication.






