AN ORDINANCE CREATING PASIG CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL, DEFINING ITS OBJECTIVES, ADMINISTRATION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD in session assembled, that:

- Section 1. **TITLE.** – This Ordinance shall be known as the “*Enabling Act of Pasig City Children’s Hospital*”.
- Section 2. **DECLARATION OF POLICY** – It is hereby declared to be the policy of Pasig City Children’s Hospital to promote and provide globally competitive quality comprehensive health for the newborn, children and adolescents and extend psychological and moral support to their families. Set the standard for excellence in pediatric, surgery, anesthesia and allied medicine training through programs that are innovative appropriate and responsive to the needs of the Pasigueños.
- Section 3. **STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES.** –
- a. To construct, establish, operate and maintain a children’s hospital for the public welfare.
 - b. To encourage and/or undertake the training of physicians, nurses, medical and radiological technicians, health officers and institutional workers on the acceptable, practical scientific conduct and implementation of children’s services.
 - c. To stimulate and underwrite scientific researches on the common causes of morbidity and mortality affecting Filipino children to include pediatric neurological diseases, perinatal medicine, neonatology, pediatric intensive care and pediatric dentistry. Multi-disciplinary collaborations both within and outside of the institution, will be promoted in the conduct of research activities.
 - d. To formulate in writing the general and specific goals of the hospital, each hospital department and service, and the basic guidelines to attain such goals.
 - e. To develop a program of patient care and hospital administration that shall include the establishment, management, operation and maintenance of a hospital organization with clearly defined lines of administration, operational and professional authority and responsibility, functional relationships and lines of communication and coordination among its various administrative and



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operational units and positions involved in the clinical and nursing aspects of patient care, budgeting and finance, personnel administration, procurement purchase and supply, buildings and ground maintenance, housekeeping, and other hospital services.

- f. To provide for the continued improvement of the hospital and its facilities and services, and for the training of all hospital personnel so that the highest professional level of patient care may be attained and maintained in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Health.
- g. To levy, collect, and receive charges and/or fees due to the hospital for goods and/or services provided for pay patients, and to solicit and receive donations to the hospital in cash or in kind, within the limits prescribed by law, rules and regulations of the Department of Health and other pertinent bodies respecting operations of public hospitals.
- h. To purchase and issue medicines, supplies and materials, equipments and property required by the hospital for its operation and maintenance and to the general provision of law relating to purchase, and to supervise the proper use and care of Hospital property including maintenance and protection of its building and grounds, fixture and equipment;
- i. To formulate guidelines to ensure competence and integrity of medical practitioners, paramedic and allied profession in the hospital and to grant incentives through wages, bonuses, security of tenure and other benefits as provide by law, and to attract and maintain such professional to stay in the service of the hospitals by striving to attain tertiary level and to aspire for accreditation as a training hospital.
- j. To open the professional services of the Nursing Service and allied profession (x-ray), Laboratory and Dental Service and the hospital facilities to the students as a training institution to the above-mentioned professions through affiliation by and between the learning institutions and the hospital as authorized by law and other ordinances, and by the rules and regulations of the Department of Health.




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


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
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 Section 4. **ADMINISTRATION.** – The Pasig City Children's Hospital shall be administered by a Board of Trustees, composed of seven (7) members to be appointed by the City Mayor. The six (6) appointive members of the Board of Trustees shall serve without salary but only honorarium for a period of three (3) years and until their successors shall have been appointed and qualified. The Director of said hospital who is a resident of the city shall be appointed by the City Mayor, subject to concurrence of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, and shall have a Salary Grade 26 with a compensation of FIVE HUNDRED ELEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SIXTY EIGHT PESOS (Php511,668.00) per annum. The Director of Pasig City Children's Hospital shall serve as Vice-Chairman of the Board. The Director shall act as the Chief Executive Officer of Pasig City Children's Hospital, with authority among others, to supervise, recommend the appointment or removal of the personnel thereof, subject to the concurrence of the Board of Trustees if already constituted and approval of the City Mayor. Any vacancy in the Board shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, and the appointee shall serve for the unexpired term. The Board of Trustees of Pasig City Children's Hospital shall elect a Chairman from among themselves, who shall be the presiding officer of the Board of Trustees four (4) members of the Board of Trustees shall constitute a quorum to transact business and any decision of such four members on any matter duly presented to the Board of Trustees shall constitute a valid and binding act of Pasig City Children's Hospital.

 Section 5. **DIRECTOR.** – The Pasig City Children's Hospital shall be under the management and supervision of a Director who must be a physician of good repute, graduate from a medical college of recognized standing and has for five years engaged in the practice of medicine.

 Section 6. **STAFFING PATTERN.** – The duly designated and/or appointed Director of Pasig City General Hospital in coordination with the Human Resource Management Office and City Budget Office shall prepare the Staffing Pattern and budget of the hospital for approval of the City Mayor and legislative enactment by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

 Section 7. **HOSPITAL FEES.** – The duly designated and/or appointed Director of Pasig City Children's Hospital in coordination with the City Health Officer and the Director of Pasig City General Hospital shall prepare the different fees to be enforced in the



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hospital, provided same is approved by the City Mayor and by an Ordinance of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.


Section 8. **ANNUAL REPORT.** - The Pasig Children's Hospital shall render to the City Mayor an annual report of its activities, income and expenditures with recommendations.


Section 9. **SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** - If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.




Section 11. **EFFECTIVITY.** - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.


