**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE PASIG CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (PCCPC), THE PCCPC TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (PCCPC-TWG), DEFINING THEIR FUNCTIONS AND COMPOSITIONS, PROVIDING THE REQUIRED BUDGET AND FOR OTHER RELATED PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Constitution guarantees the rights of children, their survival and development including but not limited to proper care and nutrition, education as well as the special protection from all forms of neglect, abuse, cruelty, exploitation and other conditions that are prejudicial to their development;

**WHEREAS**, various laws, decrees, and official memoranda have been issued by the national government in line with the inalienable rights of children and their protection from acts that constitute threats to their survival and development;

**WHEREAS**, Presidential Decree No. 603 (*The Child and Youth Welfare Code*); R.A. 9344 (*An Act Establishing A Comprehensive Juvenile Justice And Welfare System, Creating The Juvenile Justice And Welfare Council Under The Department Of Justice, Appropriating Funds Therefor And For Other Purposes*); R.A. 7610 (*An Act Providing For Stronger Deterrence And Special Protection Against Child Abuse, Exploitation And Discrimination, Providing Penalties For Its Violation, And For Other Purposes*); DILG MC Nos. 2002-121 and 2008-126 and other such policies specifically referred to the importance of the role of the Local Councils for the Protection of Children (LCPC) and therefore called for the establishment and enhancement of such bodies by the local government units;

**WHEREAS**, Pasig City takes cognizance of these calls inasmuch as the city government is unwavering in its support and protection of its children in all aspects of their development, fully realizing that their development is a paramount consideration in the total welfare and future of the Pasigueños;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session duly assembled enacts this ordinance establishing the Pasig City Council for the Protection of Children and its related provisions, to wit:

**Section 1.** TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as "The Pasig City Council for the Protection of Children Ordinance".





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**Section 2. CREATION.** By virtue of this ordinance the Pasig City Council for the Protection of Children (PCCPC) shall be hereinafter established as well as its auxiliary, the PCCPC Technical Working Group.

**Section 3. COMPOSITION OF THE PASIG CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (PCCPC).** The PCCPC shall be composed of the following:

**Section 4. SECRETARIAT.** The Chairperson shall appoint/designate three persons to serve as secretariat to the PCCPC. They will primarily serve as the administrative support to the PCCPC as the latter performs its duties and functions.

**Section 5. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.** The PCCPC shall perform the following functions.

1. Formulate resolutions for executive or legislative actions on child survival, development, protection and participation, including a Local Children and Welfare Code.
2. Provide technical assistance and other kinds of support for the establishment of Barangay Council for the Protection of Children in all the 30 barangays of the city.

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3. Prepare the Development Plan and Program for Children which is gender-fair and responsive to the needs of different groups of children from 0 to below 18 years of age.
4. Pass a resolution for the integration of Development Plan and Program for Children (DPPC) into the local development program and annual budget.
5. The DPPC shall include, but is not limited to, the following activities:
  - a. Advocacy on the rights, protection and welfare of children.
  - b. Conduct of capability building programs for stakeholders of children.
  - c. Formulation of Annual Plan for Children, Annual Investment Plan for Children, Local Children and Welfare Code, State of Children Report.
  - d. Updating of database on children.
  - e. Assistance to children in need of special protection and referral of cases of abuse and transgression to proper authorities and agencies.
  - f. Monitoring of the enforcement of national and local laws for the survival, development, protection and participation of children.
  - g. Monitoring and assessment of programs, projects and activities for children being undertaken by different agencies, offices, organizations within Pasig City. Such programs, projects and activities shall include among others the following:
    - i. Day care centers,
    - ii. Elimination of all forms of child abuse,
    - iii. Prevention of HIV/AIDS,
    - iv. Health and nutrition programs specifically for children,
    - v. Maternal and post natal care,
    - vi. Construction and maintenance of community infrastructures for children like playground, library, youth centers, etc.
    - vii. Strategies that strengthen the family like parental care and guidance, parent education, counselling and guidance.
    - viii. Training/capability-building for service providers for children.





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**Section 6. MEETINGS.** The PCCPC shall conduct regular quarterly meetings and special meetings whenever necessary. The agenda of such meetings shall be the policies, plans, programs and activities related to the promotion of rights, development and protection of children as identified in Section 5 above.

The meetings shall be supported by minutes of each meeting to be prepared by the secretariat.

**Section 7. COORDINATION, MONITORING AND EVALUATION.** Recognizing the scope and importance of ensuring the functionality of the programs formulated by the PCCPC, a Technical Working Group shall be created in order to coordinate, monitor and ensure the successful implementation of the programs, projects and activities in the Development Plan and Program for Children.

**Section 7.1. Creation of the PCCPC Technical Working Group (PCCPC-TWG).** The Technical Working Group shall be composed of technical persons from the following offices/organizations who shall be named by their heads:

**Section 7.2. Functions of the PCCPC-TWG.**

1. Provide technical support to the PCCPC.
2. Together with the secretariat , provide administrative support to the PCCPC.
3. Coordinate and monitor the implementation of the programs, projects and activities in the Development Plan and Program for Children.
4. Report regularly to the PCCPC on function 7.2.3 every two (2) months.





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**Section 8. HONORARIA.** The Technical Working Group shall be entitled to a monthly honoraria according to the following schedule and condition: Chairperson at P1,500.00; Co-Chairperson at P1,000.00; members at P 500.00 each provided that they submit the regular progress report every two months as provided in Sec. 7.2.4 above.

**Section 9. BUDGET.** One per cent (1%) of the IRA of Pasig City shall be allocated for the strengthening and implementation of the programs of the PCCPC (as provided in Section 15 of R.A. 9344).

**Section 10. BARANGAY COUNCILS FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (BCPC).** Pursuant to Article 87 of The Child and Youth Welfare Code and to the aforementioned DILG Memorandum Circulars in para 3 of this Ordinance, each of the thirty (30) barangay councils of Pasig City shall be encouraged to organize their own Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC) which shall coordinate with the PCCPC in drawing and implementing plans for the promotion of child and youth welfare in their jurisdiction.

**Section 10 (a). MEMBERSHIP OF THE BCPC.** Pursuant to the same Article 87 of The Child and Youth Welfare Code, membership to the BCPC shall be taken from responsible members of the community including a representative of the youth, as well as representatives of government and private agencies concerned with the welfare of children and youth whose area of assignment includes the particular barangay.

**Section 10 (b). BUDGET OF THE BCPC.** As provided in Section 15 of R.A 9344, one per cent (1%) of the barangay IRA shall be allocated for the strengthening and implementation of the programs of the BCPC.

**Section 11. IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.** For the purpose of the effective implementation, the PCCPC shall be responsible for formulating the implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance.

**Section 12. EFFECTIVITY.** The Pasig City Council for the Protection of Children (PCCPC) and the Technical Working Group (PCCPC-TWG) shall perform their functions and duties immediately upon the approval of this ordinance.
