AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PHILHEALTH CAPITATION FUND (PCF) FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE OUT-PATIENT BENEFIT PACKAGE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION (PHILHEALTH) FOR QUALIFIED INDIGENT MEMBERS OF PASIG CITY UNDER THE SPONSORED SECTOR COMPONENT OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (NHIP).

WHEREAS, the Philippine Constitution declares as a state policy to provide its territorial and political subdivisions genuine and meaningful local autonomy to enable them to attain their fullest development as self-reliant communities and as effective partners in the attainment or national goals;

WHEREAS, the state likewise declares that the vesting of duty, responsibility and accountability in local government units (LGUs) shall be accompanied with provisions for reasonable adequate resources to effectively carry out their functions;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of these constitutional mandates, the Philippine Congress has mandated the implementation of the Sponsored Sector Component of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP);

WHEREAS, the priority program is aimed at "Setting into motion a meaningful health care financing and delivery mechanism anchored on local government";

WHEREAS, the Sponsored Sector Component of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) provides a mechanism to identify qualified indigent members and grant them membership to NHIP through full or partial government subsidies to enable them to have access to medical care services in all NHIP accredited providers;

WHEREAS, the body, considering the beneficent features of R.A. 7875, as amended as it will vastly improve the over-all health status of the population and ultimately their general quality of life, and to rationalize the Local Government's expenditure for health, collectively agreed to adopt the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP);

WHEREAS, the creation of PhilHealth Capitation Fund is necessary to attain the purpose and objective of the Sponsored Sector Program.

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NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, to create a PhilHealth Capitation Fund from the proceeds of the out-patient benefit package to be provided by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) for qualified Sponsored members of the Pasig City under the sponsored Sector component of NHIP.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the use, management and disposition of the PhilHealth Capitation Fund shall be governed by the following rules:

1. The capitation amount shall be released on a **quarterly/semi-annual/yearly basis** by the corporation under the following conditions:
 - 1.1 The initial release shall be made within the first week of the first month of the applicable period, subject to prior accreditation of the Health Centers and payment of premium contribution by the Pasig City; and
 - 1.2 On the second week of the 1st month of succeeding periods upon submission of required reports, subject to prior payment of premiums in case of quarterly mode of premium remittance.
2. The disposition of the PCF shall be governed by the following rules:
 - 2.1 The disbursement and liquidation of the PCF shall be in accordance with pertinent government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
 - 2.2 A separate book of accounts shall be maintained by the local government unit; and
 - 2.3 Only drugs listed in the Primary Medical Care Drugs on the PNDF, medical supplies and equipment necessary to carry out the delivery of the required services, including referral fees and administrative cost not to exceed twenty percent (20%) of the capitation fund, may be charged to the PCF.
3. The Corporation may withhold the release of the subsequent quarterly PCFs due to any of the following:
 - 3.1 Delay or non-payment of premium contribution;
 - 3.2 Violation of government accounting and auditing rules and regulations on the disbursement and liquidation of the PCF; and
 - 3.3 Non-submission of the required reports under item 1.2 hereof.



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
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
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
