WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig aims to extend financial assistance to needy but capable Pasigueño students desiring to continue educational and training programs;

WHEREAS, the objective of the BCE Scholarship Program is to provide assistance in the form of scholarship grants and other forms of educational needs of the scholars;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig through Sangguniang Panlungsod Ordinance No. 41 Series of 2009 has allocated the BCE Scholarship Program to cover one thousand three hundred (1,300) college level grantees;

WHEREAS, the BCE Scholarship Committee has considered the applications of a number of deserving and capable college level students who are on their final semester in college to enable them to finish their education in as much as the program is aimed in providing continuous availability of educational support to needy but deserving students;

BE IT ORDAINED in session assembled that:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 41 Series of 2009 is hereby amended to read as follows:

NUMBER OF GRANTEES. There will be 1,500 college level scholars under the BCE Scholarship Program.

High School	-	530	-	830
College	-	1,200	-	1,500

Section 2. The fund for the number of scholars in this Ordinance shall be chargeable to any available funds of the city provided the rules and regulations pertinent thereto are strictly complied.





Section 3. The Ordinance shall take effect from the date of acceptance of the excess number of scholars in the college level covering School Year 2011-2012.


