AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AMNESTY TO DELINQUENT TRAFFIC VIOLATORS IN PASIG CITY APPREHENDED ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 12, 2013 BY CONDONING THE 5% PENALTY PER DAY IMPOSED BY SEC. 129 LETTER C OF THE 2004 TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CODE OF PASIG CITY AND IN LIEU THEREOF SHALL ONLY REQUIRE PAYMENT OF THE BASIC FINE PLUS A UNIFORM PENALTY OF 10% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE TOTAL ACCRUED PENALTY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1 Series of 2004 as amended provides for the creation of the Traffic Management Code of the City of Pasig, authorizing and implementing the issuance of Ordinance Violation Receipts to traffic violation offenders;

WHEREAS, Section 129 (C) of the 2004 Traffic Management Code of the City of Pasig as amended imposed an additional surcharge of five percent (5%) for each day of delay or failure to pay the appropriate fine within 5 days from the date of the traffic violation;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 clearly provides under Section 192 that:

“Local Government units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, incentives or reliefs under such terms and conditions as they may deem necessary.”

WHEREAS, the grant of amnesty will give the approximately 600 delinquent traffic violators most of whom are poor tricycle and jeepney drivers the opportunity to redeem their confiscated licenses at reduced and more affordable amounts to start driving and make a living for their families again;

WHEREAS, the grant of amnesty will encourage delinquent traffic violators to settle their obligations and in the process facilitate the collection of revenues for the city which otherwise would have been difficult if not impossible to collect.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASIG IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. There is hereby granted an amnesty to delinquent traffic violators in Pasig City apprehended on or before November 12, 2013 by condoning the 5% penalty per day imposed by Section 129 (C) of the 2004 Traffic Management Code of Pasig City as amended and in lieu thereof shall only require payment of the basic fine plus a uniform penalty of 10% of the amount of the total accrued penalty.




Section 2. The amnesty granted herein may be availed up to June 30, 2014.

Section 3. This Ordinance will be in effect 15 days after its publication in a general circulation in Metro Manila.




