AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS, PRINCIPALS, MANAGERS, SAFETY OFFICERS OR ADMINISTRATORS OF ALL HIGH RISE BUILDING, SCHOOLS AND HOSPITALS IN THE CITY OF PASIG TO CONDUCT MULTI HAZZARD DRILLS AND DRRM SEMINARS AMONG TENANTS, OCCUPANTS, STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES THEREIN.

WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the City of Pasig to uphold, adopt and incorporate people's constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the root causes of vulnerabilities to disasters, strengthening the City's institutional capacity for disaster risk reduction and management and building the resilience of local communities to disasters including the impacts of climate change;

WHEREAS, the City of Pasig has experienced natural and human-induced hazards/disasters which have caused extensive harm to life and damage to properties;

WHEREAS, under R.A. 10121, the LGUs are enjoined to "adopt a disaster risk reduction and management approach that is holistic, comprehensive, integrated, and proactive in lessening the socioeconomic and environmental impacts of disasters, including climate change, and promote the involvement and participation of all sectors and all stakeholders concerned at all levels, especially the local community;

WHEREAS, R.A. 10121 Section 12 states that the City LDRRMO shall be responsible for setting the direction, development, implementation and coordination of disaster risk management programs within their jurisdiction and Section 12 c. 1, 4, 13-15 and 17 from designing programs consistent with the National Council's standards, organize and conduct training, orientation and knowledge management activities on DRRM, develop and operationalize mechanisms for partnership and networking with private network, Civil Society Organizations and school volunteer corps in order to promote and raise awareness on DRRM;

WHEREAS, R.A.10121 Section 14 Integration of Disaster Risk Reduction Education into the School Curricula and Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Program and Mandatory Training for the Public Sector Employees. - states that the DEPED and other relevant agencies shall integrate disaster risk reduction and management education, including the National Service Training Program (NSTP), whether private or public, including formal and non-formal, technical-vocational, indigenous learning, and OSY courses and programs.;



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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANGLUNGSOD OF PASIG, METRO MANILA, BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN IT BY LAW, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION 1. - Owners, principals, managers, safety officers or administrators of all high rise building, schools and hospitals in the City of Pasig to conduct multi hazard drills and DRRM seminars among tenants, occupants, students and employees in the City of Pasig are hereby mandated to conduct multi hazard (fire, earthquake, flood & bomb) drills and seminar twice a year the first to be held on July of each year to coincide with the National Disaster Consciousness Month and the second to be held at the discretion of the administrator among tenants, occupants, and employees therein, PROVIDED, that in case of schools regardless of the number of floors or types of buildings, the principal shall initiate said drills and seminars or exercises.

SECTION 2. - The multi hazard drills & seminars or exercises shall be conducted with assistance, supervision and control of the Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Office, Pasig City Bureau of Fire Protection and Pasig City Philippine National Police and the corresponding certificate that a multi hazard drill and seminar had been conducted shall be issued. And, the said corresponding certificate expenditures shall be shouldered by the City Government of Pasig.

SECTION 3. - All high rise building (**Fire Code of the Philippines 2008 DIV. 19 SECTION 10.2.19.2**) A high rise building is one in which the distance between the floor of the topmost storey and the ground level is fifteen meters (15 m) or more. Building height shall be measured from the lowest level of fire department vehicle access to the floor of the highest occupiable storey..), schools and hospitals in the City of Pasig shall submit their building emergency evacuation plan including their list of disaster committee personnel with contact numbers and floor plan to the Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Office and Pasig City Bureau of Fire Protection in soft and hard copy.

SECTION 4. - Public and Private Schools are required to submit their school based DRRM Volunteer Corps or members in order to create a school network of DRRM volunteers which the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office shall schedule various DRRM related seminars and trainings for the volunteers. The various volunteer members of the schools shall form part of the City's School DRRM Volunteer Corps.

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SECTION 5. – PENALTIES: Owners, principals, managers, safety officers, or administrators of the aforesaid buildings and tenants, occupants, students and employees therein who refuse to conduct and participate in the multi hazard drills shall be punished by a fine of:

- 1st offense: - P 1,000.00
- 2nd offense - 2,000.00
- 3rd offense - 5,000.00 and revocation of permit or license to operate.


No mention of imprisonment.


SECTION 6. - All ordinances or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. - If for any reasons, any part or provisions of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. - This ordinance shall take effect immediately.


