AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 27, SERIES OF 2010, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 34, SERIES OF 1996 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR MEDICAL AND/OR BURIAL EXPENSES OF CITY EMPLOYEES WHO ARE VICTIMS OF ILLNESS AND/OR ACCIDENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Government is cognizant of the many risks and dangers faced by city employees while in the performance of their duties;

WHEREAS, illness and accidents at work can occur in a range of different circumstances;

WHEREAS, city employees who are victims of illness and/or accidents during their employment deserve financial assistance from the City Government for their medical treatments, to cover lost wages, to compensate for partial or permanent disability and for burial expenses as the case maybe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Title – This Ordinance shall be known as "AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR MEDICAL AND/OR BURIAL EXPENSES OF CITY EMPLOYEES WHO ARE VICTIMS OF ILLNESS AND/OR ACCIDENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES..

SECTION 2. Coverage – All City Employees hired on permanent, temporary, casual, contractual basis including volunteers and those under job order basis who have been employed for 2 years or more, who are victims of illness or accident are entitled to receive a grant of financial assistance from the City Government for medical expenses not to exceed Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) annually, including his/her legitimate spouse, legitimate child who is not more than eighteen (18) years old and unmarried at the time of injury or illness, or legitimate parent of an employee or official of the City Government of Pasig. Likewise, only employees are entitled to Burial Assistance from the City Government of Pasig.

SECTION 3. Entitlement – in order to be entitled for the financial assistance, conditions are set forth as follows:

- a) Emergency cases
- b) The official/employee or his beneficiaries should have incurred the sickness, injury or death is of natural cause and not self-inflicted or suicide or prohibited drug related and/or other illegal activities;
- c) The official/employee is presently in the employ of the City Government

The following shall not be considered as emergency for basic health care services:

- a) Long term treatment such as chemotherapy/radiotherapy and dialysis
- b) Cosmetic surgery or treatment
- c) Optometric surgery
- d) Dental check-up and other dental treatments
- e) Psychiatric illness
- f) Birth Related (OB) Cases

SECTION 4. – The requirements to support the release of financial assistance are as follows:

- a) Certificate of Employment
- b) Police and/autopsy report
- c) Proof of Hospitalization (original and true copy of medical certificate or certificate of confinement, official receipts of medicines and hospital bill)
- d) Death Certificate
- e) Voters Certification from Comelec that official/employee is a registered voter of Pasig City
- f) Other documents that are necessary to ensure that financial assistance is provided under existing laws and regulations.

SECTION 5. Inspection and Evaluation Committee – An Inspection and Evaluation Committee is hereby created to evaluate the employee who applies for assistance composed of the City Social Welfare Officer (CSWO) as Chairman and the Chief of Barangay Affairs Office (BAO) and the City Health Officer (CHO) as Members: Their duties are:

- a) Screen/evaluate the City officer/employee applying for financial assistance.
- b) Recommend to the City Mayor the amount of assistance to be given to the victim.
- c) Keep records of City Employees granted with financial assistance by City Government.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall be affected by such declaration.
