AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP50,000.00) TO THE VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II AND THEIR WIDOWS OF PASIG CITY TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF THEIR BURIAL EXPENSES.

WHEREAS, on August 8, 1994, Resolution No. 48, Series of 1994 was approved to provide Twenty Thousand Pesos (PHP20,000.00) as burial assistance to surviving World War II Veterans;

WHEREAS, on March 10, 1997, Resolution No. 38, Series of 1997 was approved also to provide Twenty Thousand Pesos (PHP20,000.00) as burial assistance to widows of World War II Veterans;

WHEREAS, the City Government recognize the heroism of our war veterans who had lived, fought and risked their lives for defending our freedom in those dark times.

WHEREAS, under Section 9 of R.A. 7696, the City Government is allowed to grant additional benefits to the veterans that read as follow:

Section 9 - Additional Benefits from Local Government - Notwithstanding any existing laws, rules and regulations, veterans and their dependents or survivors who received such benefits under Republic Act No. 6948 may also receive any additional benefits granted by their respective local governments."

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Pasig, in session assembled do hereby ordained that:

Section 1. The amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (PHP50,000.00) will be granted as cash burial assistance to the veterans of world war II and their widows of Pasig City as listed in the attachment of Resolution No. 38 series of 1997.

Section 2. The amount shall be taken from the General fund in the City Treasury and in accordance with all pertinent budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Section 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any Provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 4. REPEALING CLAUSE - All previous Ordinances, Resolutions rules or regulations or parts thereof which are contrary to or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.



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Section 4. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
