AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING GUIDELINES FOR THE OPERATION OF LEGITIMATE PRIVATE TOWING SERVICE COMPANIES (LPTSC) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 129 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that, "each Local Government unit shall exercise its power to create its own source of revenue".

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that, "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants".

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sanggunian Panglungsod of Pasig, that:

SECTION 1. It is unlawful for any Towing Service Company to operate within the territorial jurisdiction of Pasig City without accreditation from the City Government of Pasig.

SECTION 2. The City Mayor and/or his duly authorized representative is hereby authorized to accredit Legitimate Private Towing Service Companies (LPTSC) for the City and the Barangays of Pasig. For the City, an approved Council Resolution authorizing the City Mayor to enter into a Memorandum of agreement with a LPTSC is required, yearly approval from City Mayor or duly authorized representative is mandatory.

SECTION 3. All private towing service companies that will be accredited and will operate with the supervision of the Traffic and Parking Management Office (TPMO) will remit to the City Government thirty percent (30%) of their gross collection from their operation within the City.

SECTION 4. Barangays which will conduct clearing operations within its jurisdiction that require the services of a LPTSC can ask for its accreditation from the City Government by submitting the following:

- A letter request to the City Mayor for accreditation of a LPTSC from the concerned Punong Barangay.
- A Barangay Resolution authorizing the Punong Barangay to enter to a Memorandum of Agreement with a LPTSC.

SECTION 5. Barangays with accredited LPTSC are entitled to a remittance of 30 % of the total gross collection of the LPTSC from its operation within the territorial jurisdiction of the Barangay.

SECTION 6. Penalty: All towing services in violation of this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

| 3 rd Offense/Apprehension | - | Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and imprisonment of six (6) mos. to one (1) year upon discretion of the court. |

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All Ordinances or issuances of the City or parts thereof that are inconsistent with any of the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in any local newspaper of general circulation and/or posting in the bulletin boards in Pasig City Hall.




