WHEREAS, the Local Government Code provides that the territorial and political subdivisions of the state shall enjoy genuine and meaningful local autonomy to enable them to attain their fullest development as self-reliant communities and make them more effective partners in the attainment of national goals. Towards this end, the state shall provide for a more responsive and accountable local government structure instituted through a system of decentralization whereby local government units shall be given more powers, authority, responsibilities and resources. The process of decentralization shall proceed from the national Government to the Local Government Units;

WHEREAS, the national Historical Commission of the Philippines has issued guidelines in naming and renaming of streets, public places, public schools, plazas, bridges and other public structures by Local Government Units;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Pasig, in session assembled, do hereby ordained that:

SECTION 1. The newly constructed bridge traversing Marikina River from C-5 viaduct to P. Conducto St., Dr. Sixto Antonio Ave., connecting Brgy. Caniogan and Brgy. Ugong is hereby named Kaghinhawaan Bridge.

SECTION 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any provisions of this ordinance that may be declared or found to be invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect the other provisions which shall remain to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. The pertinent provisions of Ordinance No.12 Series of 2016 and all other ordinances, rules and regulations or part thereof in conflict or in consistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




