AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XVIII, SECTION 60 OF ORDINANCE NO. 24 SERIES OF 2016 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REVISING ORDINANCE NO. 40 SERIES OF 2001 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE TRICYCLE/PEDICAB CODE OF PASIG CITY".

WHEREAS, Article XVIII, Section 60 Ordinance No. 24 Series of 2016 states that:

**ARTICLE XVIII**  
**CREATION OF TORO DEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND**

**Section 60.** There is hereby created a TORO Development Trust Fund generated from Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR) as set forth in this Ordinance. Twenty Five Percent (25%) of all collections derived from the apprehension of tricycles violating any of the provisions of this code shall accrue to TORO to be distributed as incentives as follows:

- a) Seventeen and a half percent (17.5%) of the collected fines shall be for TORO Enforcers based on actual number of apprehensions.
- b) Five Percent (5%) of the collected fines shall be for the administrative expenses of the office (TORO). The fund shall be disbursed only for the operational expenses of the Tricycle Operation Regulatory Office, including maintenance of facilities, excluding salaries and allowances of personnel. Any unused balance at the end of the fiscal year shall be reverted to the General Fund.
- c) Two and a half percent (2.5%) shall be divided equally among all the administrative staff.
- d) All the Officials/Personnel enumerated in Section 6 (1) are to be designated by the City Mayor prior to the entitlement to the foregoing incentives.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of Pasig, in session duly assembled that:

**SECTION 1.** Article XVIII, Section 60 Ordinance No. 24 Series of 2016 is hereby amended to be read as follows:

**ARTICLE XVIII**  
**CREATION OF TORO DEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND**

**Section 60.** There is hereby created a TORO Development Trust Fund generated from Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR) as set forth in this Ordinance. Fifteen Percent (15%) of all collections derived from the apprehension of tricycles violating any of the provisions of this code shall accrue to TORO to be distributed as incentives as follows:

- a) Ten Percent (10%) of the total collections shall be given to all TORO enforcers duly deputized by the Pasig City Government based on the actual apprehensions.
- b) Two Percent (2%) of the collected fines shall be for the administrative expenses of the office (TORO). The fund shall be disbursed only for the operational expenses of the Tricycle Operation Regulatory Office, including maintenance of facilities, excluding salaries and allowances of personnel. Any unused balance at the end of the fiscal year shall be reverted to the General Fund.
- c) Three percent (3%) of the total collections shall be divided equally among the officials and Administrative Staff including the Chief TORO or any person designated as Head of the Office.
- e) Any balance of the Fifteen Percent (15%) at the end of the year shall revert to the General Fund.
- f) The grant of incentives as herein provided shall not exceed fifty percent (50%) of the annual salary of the grantee.
- g) All the enforcers and personnel are to be designated by the City Mayor or his authorized representative prior to the entitlement to the foregoing incentives.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE** – Ordinance No. 49 Series of 2017 and all ordinances, resolutions and other administrative regulations that are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY** - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in any local newspaper of general circulation and/or posting in the bulletin boards in Pasig City Hall.
