AN ORDINANCE ORGANIZING THE PASIG CITY EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT (PCECCD) COMMITTEE UNDER THE PASIG CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN AND THE ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION AND GRANTING OF PERMIT TO OPERATE AND RECOGNITION TO PUBLIC AND PRIVATE CHILD DEVELOPMENT / LEARNING CENTERS FOR 0 TO 4 YEARS OLD FILIPINO CHILDREN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the Republic Act No. 10410, known as the Early Years Act (EYA) of 2013 declares the policy of the state to promote the rights of children to survival, development and special protection with full recognition of the nature of childhood and as well as the need to provide developmentally appropriate experience to address their needs and to support parents in their roles as primary caregivers and as their children's first teachers;

WHEREAS, it is furthered on the same that the state recognizes the age from zero (0) to eight (8) years as the first crucial stage of educational developmental of which the age from zero (0) to four (4) years shall be the responsibility of the Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) Council and that the responsibility to help develop children in the formative years between age five (5) to eight (8) years shall be with the Department of Education (DepEd);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act 10410, the state shall institutionalize a National System for Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) that is comprehensive integrative and sustainable, that involves multi-sectoral and interagency collaboration at the national and local levels among government, among service providers families and communities, and among the public and private sectors, non-government organizations, professional associations and academic institutions;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the above-mentioned Republic Act defines ECCD System as the full range of health, nutrition, early education and social services development programs that provide for the basic holistic needs of young children from age zero to four years and to promote their optimum growth and development;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the same Act includes in the National ECCD System objective (i) the improvement of quality standards of public and private ECCD programs through but not limited to, a registration and credential system for a ECCD service providers and facilities;



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WHEREAS, last September 1, 2015 the ECCD Governing Board during their 25th meeting has approved the guidelines on Registration and Granting of Permit and recognition to Public and Private Child Development Centers / Learning Centers offering Early Childhood Programs for 0 to 4 years old Filipino Children as mechanisms to ensure that young children are provided access to quality services in health, nutrition and early learning in a safe and inclusive environment;

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WHEREAS, the Pasig City in its efforts to protect the rights of every children, finds it necessary to adopt the above-mentioned guidelines as it is believed by the PCECCD Council to be an instrument for the transformation of quality services in early childhood care, development and education.

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WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 23 Series of 2018 also known as "The Pasig City Children Code of 2018" stipulated the need to establish an Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) Program in every barangay.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Pasig City in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. The Creation of the Pasig City ECCD Committee – The Pasig City Early Childhood Care and Development (PCECCD) Committee is hereby created under the Pasig City Council for the Protection of Children. The Pasig City ECCD Committee shall become a consultative body that would ensure institutionalization of the ECCD System and the implementation of its components in Pasig City necessary for the holistic development of children aged zero to eight (0 to 8) years old who are in the crucial years of growth and development.

SECTION 2. Composition of the Pasig City ECCD Committee (PCECCDC) – The following shall compose the CECCDC:

SECTION 3. Functions of the PCECCDC – The Pasig City ECCD Committee shall have the following functions:

1. Ensure the adoption and implementation of the National ECCD System in Pasig City;
2. Prepare for approval the Annual Work and Financial Plan for ECCD Programs and Services;
3. Recommend policies, plans and programs for children aged 0 to 8 years old that are developmentally appropriate and gender responsive;
4. Provide technical assistance to Barangays in the establishment of Barangay ECCD Coordinating Committees and implementation of ECCD programs and services;
5. Ensure adherence of ECCD facilities and service providers to set standards; and
6. Submit necessary reports to the City Government and the national ECCD Council.

SECTION 4. Pasig City ECCD Officer and Secretariat Team – The OIC of Pasig City Day Care Service under the Pasig Social Welfare and Department is hereby designated as Pasig City ECCD Officer who shall monitor and evaluate implementation of ECCD programs and services in pasig City in coordinanton with the members of the secretariat team who shall provide administrative support services to the CECCDC:

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Section 5. Adoption of the Guidelines on Registration and Granting of Permit and Recognition to Public and Private Child Development Centers / Learning Centers. Resolution No. 15-03 of the National ECCD Council Approving the Guidelines on Registration and Granting of Permit and Recognition to Public and Private Child Development Centers / Learning Centers offering Early Childhood Care and Development Programs to 0 to 4 years old Filipino children approved by the ECCD Governing Board is hereby adopted. Members of the City ECCD Committee shall undertake necessary steps to incorporate the issuance of permit to operate and recognition to all public and private CDCs / LCs in Pasig City.

Section 6. Effectivity – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
