AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE PASIG CITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Section 1, Art. XVI of 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels, and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (5) (xi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall establish scholarship program and other incentives for deserving students, both in the public and private schools especially to the underprivileged within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the beneficiaries of this program must come from the marginalized and underprivileged families but dedicated and deserving students, who cannot afford to go to school due to poverty and high cost of education;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session duly assembled, to enact this ordinance to supersede all related ordinances and ordain that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. The scholarship program shall hereinafter be called as the "**PASIG CITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**", and shall be extended only to students who are bonafide residents of the City of Pasig.

SECTION 2. BENEFICIARIES. The beneficiaries of the Pasig City Scholarship Program shall be known as the "**PASIG CITY SCHOLARS**".

SECTION 3. OBJECTIVES. The ordinance aims to:

- Provide financial subsidy to marginalized and underprivileged but dedicated and deserving students for their educational expenses;
- Encourage the scholars to enhance their knowledge and skills, personality and self-esteem for their future career and become a responsible and productive members of society;
- Help in alleviation of poverty of the families who could not afford to send their son/daughter to school.

SECTION 4. NUMBER OF SCHOLARS. The number of scholars shall be recommended by the Pasig City Scholarship Program Committee and approved by the City Mayor subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 5. SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE. The City Mayor shall create the Pasig City Scholarship Program Committee hereinafter referred to as "Committee", composed of one (1) chairman and four (4) committee members whose appointments are vested in the City Mayor and shall perform the following duties and responsibilities, viz:

1. Enact rules and guidelines for the implementation of the scholarship program in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance;
2. Provide the criteria and qualifications of the applicants;
3. Conduct screening and evaluation of applicants;
4. Submit an annual report to the City Mayor on the implementation of the scholarship program;
5. Submit an annual budget proposal to the Finance Committee;
6. Monitor the progress of scholars and their management of the fund;
7. Recommend to the City Mayor the numbers of scholars to be accommodated in the succeeding years;
8. Determine the limitations on the number of scholar/s per family which can avail the scholarship program;
9. Determine the annual allowance to be granted in each scholar depending on their grade level; and
10. Perform such other functions as necessary to the achievement of the program.

SECTION 6. SECRETARIAT. The members of the secretariat shall be composed of four (4) members and shall be co-terminous to the City Mayor, to wit:

Further, the Secretariat shall perform the following duties and functions:

- a.) To provide administrative, operational and other support for the Committee;
- b.) Perform the administrative staff in the implementation of the program;
- c.) Monitor and update database of scholars;
- d.) Maintain a secure records of the program and distribute the Committee decisions in a timely manner;
- e.) Perform such other duties and functions as may be determined by the Committee.

SECTION 7. SUBSIDY. The rate of financial subsidy to be extended to scholars shall be as follows:

Grade level	Per month	Per Annum
1. Elementary	P1,500.00	P15,000.00
2. Junior High School	P1,950.00	P19,500.00
3. Senior High School	P1,950.00	P19,500.00
4. College	P2,250.00	P22,500.00

SECTION 8. POSTING. Qualified beneficiaries shall be personally informed by the Secretariat and full list shall be posted in two (2) conspicuous places.

SECTION 9. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

- Students/Scholars:
 - Maintain academic excellence;
 - Participate actively in civic affairs through volunteerism in community events.
- Parents/Guardians:
 - Ensure a home environment conducive to learning;
 - Actively participate in civic affairs through volunteerism in community events.

SECTION 10. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES. The implementing rules and regulations and guidelines shall be formulated by the Pasig City Scholarship Committee within thirty (30) working days from the approval of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. FUNDING. The budgetary requirements to implement this ordinance shall be chargeable against any available funds in the Office of the City Mayor subject to the existing COA rules and regulations.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions or executive orders which are inconsistent to any of the provision of this ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provisions of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not effected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
