AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS AND PUBLIC ROADS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF PASIG IN ACCORDANCE WITH REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991.

WHEREAS, Sec. 458 (a) (5) (v) of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Panglungsod has the power to regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement repair and maintenance of the same; establish bus and vehicle stops and terminals or regulate the use of the same by privately-owned vehicles which serve the public; regulate garages and the operation of conveyances for hire; designate stands to be occupied by public vehicles when not in use; regulate the putting up of signs, signposts, awnings and awning posts on the streets; and provide for the lighting, cleaning and sprinkling of streets; and public places;

WHEREAS, Sec. 458 (a) (5) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Panglungsod has the power to regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon, and when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal or encroachments and illegal constructions in public places;

WHEREAS, the Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 expressly provides that the Sangguniang Panglungsod has the sole power and authority to regulate the use of streets and roads within territorial jurisdiction of the city;

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Republic Act No. 8794 otherwise known as "An Act Imposing A Motor Vehicle User's Charge On Owners Of All Types Of Motor Vehicles And For Other Purposes" provides that "no other tax, fee or any other charge of similar nature, as the Motor Vehicle User's Charge shall be imposed by any political subdivision or unit in the country.";

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the use of streets and roads in the City of Pasig in order to fully comply with the provisions set forth by the Local Government Code of 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panglungsod in session duly assembled resolves, as it hereby resolved, to enact this ordinance and ordain that:

SECTION 1. COVERAGE. This ordinance shall cover all the public streets and public roads within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Pasig.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

- 2.1. Alley – a narrow passage way between or behind building.
- 2.2. Avenue – a broad road in a town or city typically having trees at regular interval along its sides.
- 2.3. Bridges – a structure carrying a road, path, rail road or other obstacle.
- 2.4. Motor Vehicle – a road vehicle empowered by an internal combustion engine; an automobile.
- 2.5. Road – a wide way leading from place to another, especially one with a specially prepared surface which vehicles can use.
- 2.6. Streets – a public road in town or city, typically with houses and buildings on one or both sides.
- 2.7. Traffic – vehicles moving on a road or public highway.

SECTION 3. OPENING OF STREETS AND ROADS. All public streets and public roads shall be cleared of any obstruction and be made open to the public.

SECTION 4. BARANGAY ORDINANCE AND RESOLUTION. All public streets and public roads which were affected by an ordinance or resolution enacted by a Sangguniang Barangay in violation of this ordinance shall be deemed repealed.

SECTION 5. PROHIBITION. No charges or fees in any other form such as pass stickers shall be collected by a Barangay Unit for the passage of motor vehicle to any street or road within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Pasig.

SECTION 6. PENALTIES. In case of non-compliance, appropriate administrative cases shall be filed against any local elective officials pursuant to Section 60 (c) of the Local Government Code of 1991 and other existing laws and policies.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any ordinance, resolution, or executive order which is inconsistent to any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.


