AN ORDINANCE GRANTING QUARTERLY RICE SUBSIDY ALLOWANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P2,500) AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER TO THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF PASIG AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 16, Chapter II, book 1 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, General Welfare clause under the Administrative Code provides that the City Council shall enact such ordinances and make such resolutions not repugnant to law, as may be necessary to carry into effect and discharge the powers and duties conferred upon it by law and such as shall seem necessary and proper to provide for the health and safety, to promote prosperity, improve the morals, peace and order, comfort and convenience of the city and the inhabitants thereof and the protection of property therein;

WHEREAS, the grant of rice subsidy equivalent to cash will aide city employees in their daily needs and to motivate them to work harder to render better public service;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. The quarterly rice subsidy allowance in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500) is hereby granted to all regular/permanent, temporary or casual status and contractual employees and must not have been suspended or charged administratively, civilly or criminally and must not have any derogatory record in his/her 201 file (*for the period covering the grant of the subsidy*).

SECTION 2 . The budgetary requirement to implement this Ordinance shall be chargeable against any available funds in the City Treasury, subject to existing COA rules and regulations.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE – Any ordinance, resolution or executive order inconsistent with this Ordinance or any provision hereof is hereby repealed or amended.




SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY- This ordinance shall take effect on the third and fourth quarter of year 2019 and every year thereafter.

APPROVED, this 24th day of **October 2019** at Pasig City.


