AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING GUIDELINES IN EXTENDING FINANCIAL AND RELIEF ASSISTANCE TO THE FAMILIES RESIDING WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF PASIG WHO ARE VICTIMS OF THE CALAMITY OF FIRE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (1) (iv) of same Code provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall adopt measures to protect inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their term to productive livelihood following said events;

WHEREAS, the unforeseen events such as the calamity of fire often left, if not always, our constituents with great damage not only to their properties but also to their lives;

WHEREAS, it is the consistent policy of the City Government of Pasig to provide sincere and efficient public service to its constituents, especially in times of crisis and emergencies;

WHEREAS, in order to decrease and lessen the effects of such calamity to the families concerned, it is necessary to extend financial and relief assistance to the victims of fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF PASIG, IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. Purpose. – This ordinance is enacted to extend financial and relief assistance to the families who are victims of fire in order to relieve and alleviate their sufferings from this kind of calamity.

Section 2. Coverage. – The financial and relief assistance shall only be available to the families residing within the jurisdiction of the City of Pasig who are victims of the calamity of fire.

Provided, however, the assistance shall also be available to the Pasigueño families relocated in the resettlement areas or housing projects outside the City of Pasig.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. – The following term shall be construed as:

1. Owner – a person who has dominion of a thing real or personal, corporeal or incorporeal which he has a right to enjoy and to with as he pleases, even to spoil or destroy it, as far as the law permits.
2. Renter – a person renting a residential unit with the obligation to pay.
3. Sharer – a head of the family which is neither an owner nor a renter, but residing in the same house of an owner or a renter.

Section 4. Duties and functions. – The following offices shall perform the duties and functions:

1. **The City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office shall:**
 - a. In coordination with the Bureau of Fire and Protection assigned in the City of Pasig, collect and collate information as regards to the date, time and location of the incident;
 - b. Verify the number of casualties, if any;

- c. Submit an assessment report as to the gravity of the damage caused by the fire;
 - d. Submit a final recommendation whether or not the families affected are qualified for the financial and relief assistance as herein provided.
2. **The City Social Welfare Development Office shall:**
- a. Be responsible for the evacuation of the families affected and assist in the distribution of relief assistance as provided herein;
 - b. Verify the number of families affected by the calamity of fire; and
 - c. Determine whether such families are owners, renters, or sharers.

Section 5. Consolidation of report. – Both abovementioned offices shall, in coordination with each other, consolidate and submit a final and complete report to the Office of the City Mayor for approval.

Section 6. Financial Assistance. – Upon verification of the reports submitted and after approval of the Office of the City Mayor, every family that will be victim of fire shall receive the amount of:

Classification of Victims	Amount
Owner	P10,000.00
Renter	P5,000.00
Sharer	P5,000.00

Provided, that the above amount may be superseded through a resolution approved by the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council.

Section 7. Relief Assistance. – The Office of the City Mayor may grant relief assistance in the form of food and/or non-food items to the families which are victims of fire depending on the recommendation of City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office.



Section 9. Repealing clause. – Any executive order, ordinance, or resolution not in accordance with this ordinance is deemed repealed.

Section 10. Effectivity. – This ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication.


