**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVEL AND LOITERING FOR THE PURPOSE OF MITIGATING THE SPREAD OF THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19).**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

**WHEREAS**, on 12 March 2020, the World Health Organization declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) as pandemic and the continued and accelerated spread of the COVID-19 has been observed within the National Capital Region (NCR);

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo R. Duterte on 12 March 2020 adopted Resolution No. 11, Series of 2020, of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF), effectively placing the entire NCR under community quarantine;

**WHEREAS**, in view of the foregoing, the City Government of Pasig deems it necessary to strictly implement the new curfew hours within its territorial jurisdiction as part of its precautionary measures against the widespread of COVID-19, in order to preserve and protect the lives and health of its constituents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF PASIG CITY, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED:**

**Section 1. Coverage.** – This Ordinance shall cover all persons within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Pasig.

**Section 2. Definition of terms.** – The following words shall be construed as follows:

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- Handwritten signatures: M. Pan, [unclear], [unclear]*
- Essential travel – travel that cannot be postponed as it is necessary to preserve the life, safety, and/or security of a person or a member of his/her immediate family, or to avert material damage to property. Such travel likewise includes, but is not limited to, going to and coming from work, procurement of emergency or health services, medicines, food, and household commodities, as well as deliveries of the same. It also involves travels made by government officials to perform official functions, and trips by residents to/from their houses and places of work.
  - Non-essential travel – travel that may be postponed to a later date as it is not necessary to preserve the life, safety, and/or security of a person or a member of his/her immediate family. This involves visits to family members and/or friends for leisure, socialization, and recreation.
  - Loitering – remaining in a public place without any apparent purpose and without any intention of going home despite the absence of any circumstance that would qualify said travel as “essential”.

**Section 3. Regulations.** – The City Government hereby regulates non-essential travel and loitering between the hours of 8:00 in the evening to 5:00 in the morning of the following day.

**Section 4. Exemptions.** – The following shall be exempted from the implementation of this ordinance:

- Handwritten signature: [unclear]*
- Employees who work at night such as, but not limited to, call center agents, security guards, and those in similar situations.
  - Those engaged in delivering basic necessities, such as food and medicines;
  - Those providing public transport services (buses, jeepneys, tricycles, taxicab, and the like);
  - Peace and Order personnel in the national, city and barangay levels;
  - Those engaged in responding to medical emergencies, such as doctors, nurses, ambulance drivers, and other health personnel;
  - Those responding to fire, environmental hazards, and similar emergencies;
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- g. Those providing urgent repairs and similar public works to maintain basic services and utilities, with the prior consent from the Office of the City Mayor;
- h. Those travelling to the airport for travel abroad, upon showing proof of an onward international flight that falls within or close to the curfew hours; and
- i. Those considered as essential travel as defined in Section 2 (a) of this Ordinance.

**Section 5. Enforcement.** – This Ordinance shall be implemented by the Philippine National Police - Pasig City.

**Section 6. Sanctions.** – Violation of this Ordinance shall warrant the following sanctions:

First Offense:	Censure or admonition
Second Offense:	Community Service of three (3) hours
Third Offense:	Community Service of five (5) hours

*Provided,* that the community service herein imposed shall be rendered only after the State of Calamity has been lifted in the City of Pasig.

**Section 7. Separability clause.** – If any or part of ordinance is declared unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in effect.

**Section 8. Repealing clause.** – All Ordinances, Resolutions, Executive Orders inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are deemed repealed.

**Section 9. Effectivity.** – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval due to the urgency of the concerns caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Should the declared state of national emergency be lifted, the regulations imposed in this Ordinance shall be suspended accordingly.
