AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING A CODING SCHEME REGULATING MOBILITY OF RESIDENTS TO ENSURE STRICT QUARANTINE PROTOCOL AND SOCIAL DISTANCING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF PASIG CITY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922, declaring the State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Likewise, Proclamation No. 929, Series of 2020 was subsequently issued, declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease, through Resolution No.11, Series of 2020 dated March 12, 2020 raised the Code Alert system for COVID-19 to Code Red Sub-level 2 and recommended strict social distancing, suspension of classes, limiting of mass gatherings, community quarantine, limiting of work in the executive branch of government and promoting flexible work arrangements for a period of thirty (30) days in the National Capital Region;

WHEREAS, the IATF for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease, through Resolution No.20, Series of 2020 dated April 15, 2020, announced that President Rodrigo R. Duterte had approved its recommendation to extend the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Luzon until April 30, 2020, and resultantly extended the same until May 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020 Republic Act 11469 otherwise known as "The Bayanihan to Heal as One Act" was approved mandating all Local Government Units to act in accordance with the rules and directives of the National Government in implementing the standards of the community quarantine, among others;



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WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig, through the Sangguniang Panlungsod, deems it necessary to adopt measures by the strict implementation of the ECQ, which include stringent social distancing measures and limited movement;

WHEREAS, due to the continuous rise in the number of COVID-19 cases and fatalities, a Barangay Coding Scheme is hereby implemented in every barangay in the City of Pasig based on a schedule for each barangay and regulating mobility of its residents, to ensure strict quarantine protocol and social distancing.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD resolves, as it hereby resolved, that:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE –This Ordinance shall be known as the “**BARANGAY CODING SCHEME**”.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. – The City Government of Pasig, recognizing the grave threat to the health, security, and lives of its constituents due to the pandemic COVID-19, strongly resolves to adopt various measures in the pursuit of suppressing the pandemic within its jurisdiction. To address the needs of the populace, the City Government has consistently and continuously adopted innovative measures, within the scope of and in adherence to the directives of the National Government for the purpose.

SECTION 3. ISSUANCE OF PERMIT TO LEAVE PREMISES (PLP). – The City Government of Pasig through its Pasig City Incident Management Team (IMT) shall issue onePLP to every household in Pasig City, to be distributed by the Philippine National Police (PNP).

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SECTION 4. NAMED HEAD OF HOUSEHOLD/REPRESENTATIVE. –The PLP will indicate therein the name of the head of household or the household's chosen representative, who will be the designated holder of the same. However, in case the named head of household/representative is indisposed or unavailable due to justifiable reason, a substitute representative of his or her household may use the PLP in his or her stead, only after and provided that the substitute representative applies for and obtains a certification from his or her barangay.

In the event that the holder of the PLP is unable to drive for purposes of essential travel, he or she may be accompanied by at most one (1) companion who will serve as his or her driver, provided that the companion **remains** inside the motor vehicle at all times.

SECTION 5. USES OF THE PLP. – The PLP shall be **allowed** to be used solely for essential travel. The following constitute the parameters attendant to the use of the PLP:

- a. The PLP holder is authorized to leave the premises of his or her house **solely** for the purpose of **essential travel**, including but not limited to:
 - i. Purchase of basic necessities such as food, water, medicine; and
 - ii. Performance of basic business actions in commercial establishments;
- b. The PLP holder shall, after the performance of essential travel, leave the business or commercial establishment immediately and go back to his or her residence.

SECTION 6. PROHIBITED ACTS. – No resident shall be allowed to go outside his or her house premises during the ECQ. Furthermore, no holder of the PLP shall be allowed to go outside his or her house premises during a day not included in their barangay's allowable essential travel days. This prohibition includes those residing in gated subdivision and common areas of condominium buildings.



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SECTION 7. SCHEDULE PER BARANGAY. – Each barangay shall strictly enforce the Barangay Coding Scheme indicated in this *Ordinance*.

The schedule for PLP holders and their allowable essential travel days are as follows:

The City Mayor reserves the right to adjust the schedule after due notice based on the report by the Pasig City IMT.

SECTION 8. EXEMPTIONS TO THE BARANGAY CODING SCHEME. – The following residents shall be exempted from the implementation of this *Ordinance*:

- Employees who work in essential establishments as defined by the IATF issuances and guidelines such as those Authorized Persons Outside Residence; and
- Those holders of special permits issued by the barangay and/or the City Government of Pasig, for the purpose and period indicated in the permit.

SECTION 9. BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS. – Business and commercial establishments allowed to operate during the ECQ are exempt from the Barangay Coding Scheme, and may continue to operate during all seven (7) days of the week.



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However, each business and commercial establishment is required to observe social distancing and is enjoined to require the presentation of proof of any visitor or customer to show that he or she is allowed outside for essential activities as stated in Section 5 hereof, in the form of the PLP. Should a visitor or customer fail to prove that he or she is part of those allowed to be out on a particular day, the business and commercial establishment is tasked to refuse entry to the individual and report the same to the proper authorities.

All business and commercial establishments are mandated to display the schedule and are conscripted to abide the same in each of their premises. Any establishment found in violation of the provisions of this *Ordinance* will be subject to penalties which may include fines to immediate closure.

SECTION 10. EXEMPTIONS REGARDING BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS TO THE BARANGAY CODING SCHEME. – Business and commercial establishments which may accept customers regardless of proof presented, and despite the regulations attendant to the Barangay Coding Scheme are the following:

- a. Businesses engaged in the selling of medicines, including but not limited to pharmacies and drug stores;
- b. Funeral homes, for purposes allowed by the National Government; and
- c. Those neighborhood establishments within the barangay selling essential goods. Provided, that the operations of these establishments are properly coordinated with the barangay concerned.

SECTION 11. PENALTIES. – Any person, natural or juridical, found guilty of this *Ordinance* shall be meted a penalty of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and/or imprisonment of six (6) months upon the discretion of the proper court or based on the penalty scheme found in Republic Act No. 11332, otherwise known as Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act, and other pertinent laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 12. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES. – The Philippine National Police, with the assistance of the *Batas Ciudad* Enforcement Office, Office of Public Safety and the barangay concerned are tasked with the proper and expedient implementation of this *Ordinance*.



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
SECTION 13. REPORT TO THE SANGGUNIANG. – The IMT shall report to the Sangguniang Panlungsod regarding the recent developments in the situation on the COVID-19 pandemic in the City of Pasig.

SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – Should any article, section or regulation of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof other than the article, section or regulation so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.


SECTION 15. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.– This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.






