WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, on 16 March 2020, the national government declared the entire Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine following the effects of the COVID-19 which affected operations of business establishments and hence, only those classified as essential travel were allowed to go outside and perform their jobs;

WHEREAS, on 1 June 2020, the national government declared that the National Capital Region will be placed under the General Community Quarantine ("GCQ") which allows several business operations in the National Capital Region and as a result, most residents have returned to their respective jobs;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 06, Series of 2020, regulated the non-essential travel and loitering from 8:00 o'clock in the evening to 5:00 o'clock in the morning of the following day, which the Sangguniang Panlungsod finds not applicable anymore since under the guidelines provided in GCQ, most of the residents have returned to their respective jobs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF PASIG CITY, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO.6 SERIES OF 2020; REGULATIONS. – The City Government hereby regulates non-essential travel and loitering between the hours of **10:00 o'clock in the evening to 5:00 o'clock in the morning** of the following day.

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All Ordinances, Resolutions, Executive Orders inconsistent with the provisions of the ordinance are deemed repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. – This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
