AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING ALL DEADLINES FOR MONETARY OBLIGATIONS IN FAVOR OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF PASIG FROM THE PERIOD OF 01 AUGUST TO 31 OCTOBER 2020, WITHOUT ADDITIONAL PENALTIES FROM THE TIME THE OBLIGATION WAS EXTENDED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 7 of Republic Act (RA) No. 11332 provides that the President of the Republic of the Philippines shall declare a State of Public Health Emergency in the event of an epidemic of national and/or international concern which threatens national security in order to mobilize governmental and nongovernmental agencies to respond to threat;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 929 was issued on 16 March 2020 declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to the Corona Virus Disease 2019 enjoining all government agencies and local government units (LGUs) to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the treat of Covid-19;

WHEREAS, the number of cases has steadily been soaring, with a rising number of infections and even deaths occurring within the populace as a result of the pandemic;

WHEREAS, in a public statement made on 2 August 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte approved the recommendation of the Department of Health and placed the entire Metro Manila, and the neighboring provinces, under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) for two (2) weeks or from 04 to 18 August 2020; and

WHEREAS, a reprieve may be made on the part of the Pasig City Government to extend the deadlines for due monetary obligations, in order to lessen the burdens currently crippling the Pasig City constituency, and to minimize the essential travel of individuals, as well to give the affected constituents additional time by which to comply with these obligations;

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING ALL DEADLINES FOR MONETARY OBLIGATIONS IN FAVOR OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF PASIG FROM THE PERIOD OF 01 AUGUST TO 31 OCTOBER 2020, WITHOUT ADDITIONAL PENALTIES FROM THE TIME THE OBLIGATION WAS EXTENDED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** as it is **ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Pasig, in session duly assembled, the following:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. – The purpose of this Ordinance is to extend the deadlines for monetary obligations in favor of the Pasig City Government in order to alleviate the obligations owed during this pandemic period, and to give the affected constituents additional time by which to comply with these obligations.

SECTION 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO COMPLY WITH MONETARY AND NON-MONETARY OBLIGATIONS TO THE PASIG CITY GOVERNMENT. – The deadlines for the payment of all monetary obligations duly authorized and imposed by the Pasig City Government within its territorial jurisdiction as of 01 August 2020, shall be extended up to 31 October 2020. *Further*, the counting of the period within which to pay these monetary obligations shall likewise be suspended during the said period. *Further*, as a result of the moving of deadlines of monetary obligations and the suspension of the counting of the period within which to pay monetary obligations, no interest, surcharge, or any form of monetary payment accruing on or due and demandable during the period provided.

SECTION 3. MONETARY OBLIGATIONS; SCOPE OF OBLIGATIONS INCLUDED IN THE EXTENSION. – The monetary obligations include Real Property Taxes, Business Taxes, Transfer Taxes, Amusement Taxes, Franchise Taxes, Garbage and Inspection fees, and any other monetary obligations in favor to the City Government of Pasig.

SECTION 4. NO WAIVER OF EXISTANT AND CURRENTLY SUBSISTING PENALTY CHARGES. – All local tax delinquencies prior to the effectivity of this Ordinance shall remain, and shall be due and demandable following the expiration of the deadline set herein. The applicable interests, penalties, and surcharges shall begin to run again and shall be due and demandable after the lapse of the effectivity of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. GRANT OF TAX CREDIT. – A tax credit is granted for taxpayers with registered businesses in Pasig City who have incurred penalties on their third quarter 2020 business tax renewal. The tax credit shall be equivalent to any penalty in the form of surcharges and interests imposed for the period 21 July -31 July 2020.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - Should any article, section or regulation of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof other than the article, section or regulation so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. - All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.


SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


