AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTING A UNIFORM CURFEW WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF PASIG DURING THE IMPOSITION OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE STATUS.

WHEREAS, Section 7 of Republic Act (RA) No. 11332 provides that the President of the Republic of the Philippines shall declare a State of Public Health Emergency in the event of an epidemic of national and/or international concern which threatens national security in order to mobilize governmental and nongovernmental agencies to respond to threat;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 929 was issued on 16 March 2020 declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to the Corona Virus Disease 2019 enjoining all government agencies and local government units (LGUs) to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the treat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2020, the IATF convened to analyze current scientific data and apply the parameters to determine the appropriate community quarantine or social distancing measures that should be implemented in different provinces, highly-urbanized cities (HUCs), and independent component cities (ICCs) in the country;

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2020, the IATF approved and issued the amended Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with the intention to harmonize and codify existing policies of the IATF and member-agencies pertaining to community quarantine, which shall be applied to all regions, provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays placed under community quarantine;

WHEREAS, it is one of the goals of community quarantine to regulate and limit the travel of individuals in order to assist in the prevention of the further spread of infection by reason of the COVID-19;



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WHEREAS, in adherence to the national government, the Pasig City Government mandates to limit and regulate travel during this pandemic by way of a uniform curfew for all Pasig City residents, to regulate any outside excursions especially during night time.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** as it is **ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Pasig, in session duly assembled, the following:

SECTION 1.SHORT TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be referred to as “The Uniform Curfew Ordinance of Pasig City 2020.”

SECTION 2.PURPOSE. – The purpose of this Ordinance is to set a uniform curfew schedule that will automatically apply when a community quarantine status is declared by the national government. The application of the curfew will be immediate and executory without need for a prior announcement from the City Government of Pasig.

SECTION 3.INDIVIDUALS COVERED BY THIS ORDINANCE. –All residents of Pasig City, whether registered voters or non-registered, all transient visitors in Pasig City, without exception save for exempted individuals in Section 6 of this Ordinance, are strictly mandated to comply with the stated uniform curfew by reason of the community quarantine.

SECTION 4.CITY-WIDE UNIFORM CURFEW. - If Pasig City is declared to be included in the areas under Enhanced Community Quarantine or Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine, city-wide curfew will be from 8PM-5AM.

If Pasig City is declared to be included in the areas under General Community Quarantine or Modified General Community Quarantine, the city-wide curfew will be from 10PM – 5AM.

If Pasig City is declared as included in the areas under the “New Normal” or areas with no existing quarantine status, or any quarantine status not labeled as the aforementioned, there will be no curfew imposed.

The directed times of curfew are without prejudice to any national or local government issuance particularly dictating a different time or day of curfew. In case of conflict between a later national or local government issuance and this Ordinance, the former will govern.

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SECTION 5. LOCAL AREA CURFEW.—For those localized and/or specific areas which need to be placed under a different schedule of curfew for reasons of health, security, etc, the City Mayor of Pasig through Executive Order shall declare a localized area curfew which shall supersede Section 4 of this Ordinance, for the period indicated in the Executive Order, and applicable only to the particularly stated area.

SECTION 6. EXEMPTED INDIVIDUALS TO THE UNIFORM CURFEW.— All health care workers, government employees performing part of the skeletal staff, peace and security employees, and other individuals declared as essential by the national government are deemed Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APOR) and shall be exempt from the restrictions listed in Sections 4 and 5 of this Ordinance.

Transportation workers, including drivers and operators of tricycles, drivers, and operators of company shuttle services, and drivers and operators of PUVs which have been contracted as company shuttle service shall be considered APORs and exempt from the restrictions listed in Sections 4 and 5 of this Ordinance.

The exemptions in this Section are without prejudice to the declaration of the national or local government that the individuals named here will be included in those not permitted or regulated to travel outside. Should an APOR lose its authorized status by such declaration, he or she shall be mandated to adhere to the schedules listed in this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. – PENALTIES. – Any violator of the provisions of this Ordinance will be subject to the following fines:

FIRST OFFENSE	Fine of P500.00
SECOND OFFENSE	Fine of P1,000.00
THIRD AND SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE	Fine of P2,000.00 or imprisonment of 2 months upon the discretion of proper court.

The City Government in close coordination with the barangays shall strictly implement the monitoring and meting out of penalties to any violators.

SECTION 9. - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - Should any article, section or regulation of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof other than the article, section or regulation so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.



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SECTION 10. - REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect. However, the existing curfew ordinance for minors shall continue to subsist even during the new normal.


SECTION 11. - EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
