AN ORDINANCE FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE CEMETERIES, MEMORIAL PARKS, AND COLUMBARIES FROM 29 OCTOBER TO 4 NOVEMBER 2020, PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 929 was issued on 16 March 2020 declaring a state of calamity throughout the Philippines due to the Corona Virus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") enjoining all government agencies and local government units (LGUs) to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases Resolution No. 72, paragraph (b), dated 17 September 2020, provides for the rules which govern all activities relating to the observance of *Undas* season in all private and public cemeteries, memorial parks, including columbariums and the like;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig, in adherence to the guidelines issued by the national government, implemented various measures to prevent the further spread of the disease within its territorial jurisdiction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF PASIG, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION 1. TEMPORARY CLOSURE. – All public and private cemeteries, memorial parks, including columbariums and the like shall be closed to visitors from 29 October to 4 November 2020.

SECTION 2. APPLICATION OF BARANGAY CODING SCHEME. – To limit the people from gathering from one place at the same time and to strictly observe the health protocols during the *Undas* season, the Barangay Coding Scheme shall be implemented before and after the dates specified in the temporary closures of places as mentioned in the preceding section. Provided, **only residents of Pasig** shall be authorized to visit in the said areas during the dates prescribed below, to wit:

Provided, further, non-residents of Pasig shall not be allowed enter the aforementioned places during the dates provided herein. However, non-residents shall be permitted before and after the dates wherein residents are authorized to do so.

SECTION 3. PROOF OF RESIDENCE. – Residents from different *barangays* shall, before entering the premises of the aforementioned places, present proof of residence such as, but not limited to, *barangay* certificate, identification card, or quarantine pass issued by the proper authorities.

SECTION 4. AGE RESTRICTIONS. – Age restrictions shall not apply to visitors of the aforementioned places.

SECTION 5. HEALTH PROTOCOLS. – Wearing of masks, face shields and observance of social distancing shall be strictly implemented to visitors.

SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES. – The Peace and Order Department, together with Philippine National Police assigned in the city, shall be tasked to monitor to situation during the *Undas* season, provide security and safety to the visitors, and implement this *Ordinance* and other related measures.

SECTION 7. PENALTY. – Any person, natural or juridical, who violates the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be meted out a fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) and a suspension of permit to operate for a period of seven (7) days if the same is a juridical entity.

SECTION 8. OTHER PERTINENT LAWS. – The existing ordinances, executive orders, and laws, rules and regulations issued by the City Government and the National Government shall remain to be in force and effect.


SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, resolutions, circulars, memoranda, orders and other issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – Should any provision of this Ordinance or any portion hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions or portions hereof not affected by invalidity or unconstitutionality shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY. – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.




