AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 56, SERIES OF 2017 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS " AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING EXCESSIVE, UNNECESSARY AND UNUSUALLY LOUD SOUNDS GENERATED FROM VIDEOKE/KARAOKE SYSTEMS OR OTHER AMPLIFIED AUDIO DEVICES WITHIN THE RESIDENTIAL AREAS AND ALONG PUBLIC STREETS IN PASIG CITY, AND FURTHER PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, SUBJECT TO ALL LAWS AND EXISTING LEGAL RULES AND REGULATIONS", AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 expressly provide that, "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants";

**WHEREAS**, on March 9, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922, declaring the State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Likewise, Proclamation No. 929, Series of 2020 was subsequently issued, declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease, through Resolution No.11, Series of 2020 dated March 12, 2020 raised the Code Alert system for COVID-19 to Code Red Sub-level 2 and recommended strict social distancing, suspension of classes, limiting of mass gatherings, community quarantine, limiting of work in the executive branch of government and promoting flexible work arrangements for a period of thirty (30) days in the National Capital Region;

**WHEREAS**, on June 19, 2020, Department of Education (DepEd) issued Department Order No. 12, Series of 2020 entitled "ADOPTION OF BASIC EDUCATION LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021 IN LIGHT OF THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY", that provides the plans and measures of DepEd in the implementation of distance learning including the use of online or e-learning class;

**WHEREAS**, all of the public and private schools located within the City of Pasig are now using online platform for their class. The City Government of Pasig in adherence with the guidelines issued by the National Government and other agencies concerned in managing COVID-19, deems it necessary to enact an Ordinance that will preserve the comfort and convenience of every student and teachers despite the adverse effect brought by the pandemic.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF PASIG IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** – There is hereby amended Section 6 of the Ordinance, which shall now be read as follows:

**Section 6. Operation and Use**

Operation and use of videoke/karaoke system and other amplified devices in residential areas and along public streets or road sides shall be strictly prohibited within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Pasig from Monday to Friday, **except holidays**, at six o'clock in the morning until six o'clock in the evening (6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) and no permit shall be issued during the prohibited hours herein.

Moreover, the operation and use of the devices in the areas mentioned in the preceding paragraph shall be prohibited from Monday to Sunday at ten o'clock in the evening until six o'clock in the morning (10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.).

As such, whenever allowed and not included in the prohibited days and hours mentioned in the last two preceding paragraphs, applicants shall first obtain a barangay permit for the operation and use of the devices as provided in Ordinance No. 56 series of 2017.

For this purpose, residential area shall mean an urban area within the city for dwelling and/or housing purposes.



**SECTION 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** – If for any reason any part or provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.EFFECTIVITY.**This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.


