

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR THE GRANT OF ASSISTANCE FOR THE VICTIMS OF TYPHOON ULYSSES, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, on 12 November 2020, Typhoon Ulysses struck the country wherein thousands of houses were submerged by the massive floods, prompting residents to proceed to evacuation sites. As precautionary measure, the City Government of Pasig prepared evacuation sites in order to lessen the damage to life and property of its residents;

**WHEREAS**, families who live in the danger zones were most affected by the massive floods brought by Typhoon Ulysses causing distraction to the properties and houses which are made up of light materials;

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Pasig continues to provide assistance to its affected residents in the form of preparing meals in the evacuation areas, distribution of relief goods and relief kits;

**WHEREAS**, on 8 December 2008, in the case of *MMDA vs. Concerned Residents of Manila Bay*, the Supreme Court issued a Continuing Mandamus which directed local government units, among others, to remove encroachments along the Pasig-Marikina-San Juan Rivers and connecting waters and *esteros* in Metro Manila to restore and maintain Manila Bay's water to a safe level for bathing;

**WHEREAS**, most of affected families' houses are made up of light materials and are within the danger zones near the river, floodways, creeks and other waterways and in order to prevent further damage to the lives and properties of its residents, the City Government of Pasig deems it necessary to grant assistance for the affected families who are victims of Typhoon Ulysses subject to some conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF PASIG IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:

**SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** – The following terms shall mean:

- a. **Danger zones** shall refer to a location where the presence of a hazard may cause loss of life, injury or other health impacts and property damage. Danger zone includes lands adjacent to *esteros*, railroad tracks, garbage dumps, riverbanks, waterways, transmission lines, fault lines and areas prone to fire, liquefaction and landslides. This also refers to an area near rivers, floodways, creeks, and other waterways covered by the Continuing Mandamus Order issued by the Supreme Court.
- b. **Totally damaged and/or washed out house** shall refer to house that is no longer suitable for abode.
- c. **Affected families** shall refer to families who are affected by Typhoon Ulysses.
- d. **National Housing Authority (NHA)** shall refer to a national government agency responsible for public housing in the country.

**SECTION 2. GRANT OF ASSISTANCE.** – Only affected families whose houses were totally damaged and/or washed out by the massive flood brought by Typhoon Ulysses can avail the grant of assistance herein provided in the following options:

- a. To avail a NHA-funded housing unit located at San Guillermo Heights, Barangay Lagundi, Morong, Rizal with additional financial assistance in the amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00); or
- b. To aid them in their relocation within the city, affected families may be given financial assistance in the amount equivalent to the prevailing minimum wage multiplied by sixty (60) days pursuant to Republic Act No. 7279 and its implementing rules and regulations.

**SECTION 3. CONDITIONS.** – Whenever the affected families availed the grant of assistance under the preceding section, they are not allowed to return in the danger zones and/or construct therein another house composed of light materials within the territorial jurisdiction of Pasig.

**SECTION 4. DISQUALIFICATIONS.** – Affected families who breached the conditions set herein shall be:

- a. Perpetually disqualified as beneficiary of any of the city's housing program; and
- b. In the event that affected families returned in danger zones and constructed therein another house composed of light materials, such house shall be automatically removed by the proper authorities.

**SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTING OFFICE.** – The Task Force Pabahay, under the Office of the City Mayor, shall perform the following duties and functions:

- a. Implement the mandate of this *Ordinance*;
- b. Primarily tasked in the determination whether or not the affected family's house can be considered totally damaged or washed out brought by the massive flood;
- c. Assist the affected families to obtain the grant of assistance as herein provided;
- d. Assist the affected families in relocating to the relocation sites;
- e. Coordinate with the proper national government agencies for effective and efficient implementation of this *Ordinance*;
- f. In coordination with Barangays, ensure that the affected families who availed the grant of assistance shall not return to the danger zones; and
- g. Submit the list of all affected families who will avail the grant of assistance to the Office of the Mayor for approval.

**SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS.** – The funds to cover the grant of assistance shall be taken from any available funds in the City Treasury subject to existing COA rules and regulations.

**SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** – Should any provision of this Ordinance or any portion hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions or portions hereof not affected by invalidity or unconstitutionality shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE.** – All ordinances, resolutions, circulars, memoranda, orders and other issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


**SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** – This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


