**AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE ADJUSTMENT, SETTING, AND ADOPTION OF REASONABLE REGULATORY FEES AND CHARGES OF PASIG CITY AND HEREBY AMENDING THE 2017 REVISED PASIG REVENUE CODE AND THE PASIG CITY 2016 REVISED TRAFFIC AND PARKING MANAGEMENT CODE, AS WELL AS INTEGRATING THE PROVISIONS OF THE NATIONAL BUILDING CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES.**

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**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers to ensure, support, and enhance, among others, economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants. *Further*, R.A. No. 7160 grants authority to the Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact ordinances and approve resolutions, to ensure, among others, efficient and effective delivery of basic services and facilities;

**WHEREAS**, Section 186 of Republic Act No. 7160 allows local government units to exercise the power to levy taxes, fees, or charges on any base or subject not otherwise specifically enumerated in the local government code or taxed under the provisions of the National Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or other applicable laws: *Provided*, that the taxes, fees, or charges shall not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, confiscatory or contrary to declared national policy. *Provided further*, that the ordinance levying such taxes, fees, or charges shall not be enacted without any prior public hearing conducted for the purpose.

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government and the Department of Finance, in an effort to ensure that local government units will be more business-friendly and will set reasonable fees and charges in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160 as well as Republic Act No. 11032 or the Ease of Doing Business Law, promulgated Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 2019-01 on 17 May 2019 or the Guidelines for the Review, Adjustment, Setting and/or Adoption of Reasonable Regulatory Fees and Charges of Local Government Units, the same to encourage and empower local government units to revise their rates through the issuance of an appropriate and compliant ordinance;



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**WHEREAS**, the Pasig City Government seeks to build a strong enabling environment for good local governance and to serve its constituents fairly, particularly the business sector, through the review, adjustment, and/or revision of their local revenue fees and charges, in order to eliminate nuisance and unnecessary fees, and set amounts more in consonance with the striking of the balance between high rates which discourage investors and low rates which compromise the revenue generation of the City.

**WHEREAS**, a sound review of the existing fees was undertaken by the Pasig City Government, through a streamlined process involving the active involvement and consultation with all office and department heads as regard to the fees charged, and with active consultation with the private sector for recommendations, resulting in the recommended changes in the 2017 Pasig City Revenue Code;

**WHEREAS**, it is advocated that a change to the same will both address concerns brought up over the previous years and ensure Pasig City's growing status as a "business friendly" City which also takes into consideration the welfare of its constituents.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **ORDAINED** as it is **ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Pasig, in session duly assembled, the following:

**SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** - It shall be the policy of the Pasig City Government to set reasonable fees and charges as provided for by the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and to ensure a balance between recovering the cost of services and the ease of doing business, in compliance with Republic Act No. 11032 otherwise known as the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018.

**SECTION 2. LEGAL BASES.** - The following shall comprise the legal bases for the amendment of the 2017 Revised Pasig City Revenue Code (hereinafter referred to as the "**Revenue Code**", for brevity) and the Pasig City 2016 Revised Traffic and Parking Management Code (hereinafter referred to as "**Traffic Code**," for brevity), particularly to the scope of the regulatory fees set therein:

2.1. Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991:

2.1.1 Sections 134, 142, 151, and 152 allow provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays to impose and collect taxes, fees, and charges on business and occupation and on the practice of any profession and calling.



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2.1.2. Section 147 provides that fees and charges imposed by municipalities should be reasonable and commensurate to the cost of regulation, inspection, and licensing before any person may engage in such business or occupation, or practice of such profession or calling. *Further*, Article 233 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Local Government Code provides that no such fee or charge shall be based on capital investment or gross sales or receipts of the person or business liable therefore.

2.1.3. Section 153 stipulates that LGUs may collect reasonable fees and charges for services rendered.

2.1.4. Section 130 requires that taxation and other revenue-raising powers of LGUs shall be governed by the following principles: a) uniform in each local government unit; b) equitable and based as far as practicable on the taxpayer's ability to pay, levied and collected only for public purposes, not to be unjust, excessive, oppressive, or confiscatory, and not be contrary to law, public policy, national economic policy, or in the restraint of trade; c) collections shall in no case be let to any private person; d) collections shall inure solely to the benefit of, and be subject to the disposition by the local government unit levying the tax, fee, charge or other imposition; and e) evolve a progressive system of taxation.

2.1.5. Section 132 stipulates that the power to impose a tax, fee or charge to generate revenue under the LGC shall be exercised by the LGU concerned through an appropriate ordinance.

2.1.6. Sections 444(3)(iv), 455(3)(iv) and 465(3)(iv) provide that licenses and permits are to be issued by the local chief executives.

2.1.7. Section 55(c) provides that the local chief executive may veto an ordinance or resolution only once. The Sanggunian may override the veto of the local chief executive by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all its members, thereby making the ordinance effective even without the approval of the local chief executive concerned.

2.1.8. Section 187 stipulates that public hearing is mandatory prior to the enactment of the LGC.

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2.1.9. Sections 56 and 57 provide that the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan and Pangguniang Barangay shall forward to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan respectively the approved ordinances. Within the time prescribed therein, the appropriate Sanggunian shall review the forwarded approved ordinance to determine whether such is beyond the power of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Bayan concerned or whether the barangay ordinance is consistent with law and city or municipal ordinances.

2.1.10. Section (d) provides that if no action has been taken by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan within thirty (30) days after submission of such ordinance or resolution, the same shall be presumed consistent with law and therefore valid.

2.1.11. Section 188 requires that within ten (10) days after their approval, certified true copies of all provincial, city, and municipal tax ordinances or revenues shall be published in full for three (3) consecutive days in a newspaper of local circulation, the same shall be posted in at least two (2) conspicuous and publicly accessible places.

2.2. Accordingly, in Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 2019-01 dated 17 May 2019 or the *Guidelines for the Review, Adjustment, Setting and/or Adoption of Reasonable Regulatory Fees and Charges of Local Government Units*, the following considerations attendant to the policy of this Ordinance was enumerated:

2.2.1 In the succeeding revision of the rates, LGUs may have an option to adjust the rate of imposition or last revision of the subject rates of fees and charges by indexing approach: *Provided*, that there are no changes in the variables used in the computation and subject to the guidelines to be issued by the DOF, through the BLGF.

2.2.2 Subsequent to the adjustment of the rate of imposition, such revision shall be as much as possible, be uniform for similar or comparable services and functions offered by LGUs.

2.2.3. The revised rates shall be imposed through the issuance of an appropriate ordinance and compliance to all legal requirements including the conduct of a public hearing and publications.



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**SECTION 3. SCOPE OF APPLICATION** – The amendments introduced herein shall form part of the new Pasig City Revenue Code as well as the new Pasig City Traffic Code.

Any amendments made here will be limited solely to all regulatory fees or charges of the City. For this purpose, a “charge” is defined as the pecuniary liability, as rent or fees against a persons or property in exchange for the use or utility of a facility or service of the government, while a “fee” is defined as a charge fixed by law or ordinance for the regulation or inspection of a business or activity.

Any amendment is exercised under the scope and jurisdiction of the Pasig City Government to amend all fees except for those charges or fees where the rate or the method for determining the rate has already been prescribed under the Local Government Code and/or other statutes or special laws.

**SECTION 4. AMENDMENTS TO THE 2017 REVISED PASIG CITY REVENUE CODE** – The following fees, per section, comprise the amendments to the fees and charges:

**4.1. Fees charged by the Office of the City Administrator**

**4.1.1. Section 98 of the Pasig City Revenue Code, which reads:**

*Section 98. Imposition of Tax. – The City Administrator shall issue the permit on the hereunder imposed tax on ambulant and itinerant amusement operators during fiestas, fairs, sports, physical fitness, business, advertisements, and the like, to wit:*

Section 148. Imposition of Fee.- There shall be imposed the following fees on every person, whether private, local and government agencies, except those specifically exempted by law, who shall make or cause to be made any excavation or diggings on public or private streets or thoroughfares, including passageways, sidewalks within the City.

Said fee will supplement other sources of revenues for the operations and maintenance of the City Environment and Natural Resources Office and other city environmental projects.*

Likewise, a City Environmental Permit to Operate will only be issued after compliance with the conditions set forth under the issued CEC and as a requirement for the issuance of Mayor's Permit-to-Operate and upon payment to the City Treasurer of an Annual Environmental Inspection Fee in accordance with the following schedule:*

**4.3.2. Section 235 of the 2017 Pasig Revenue Code, which reads:**

*Section 235. Penalties. Any violation on this Article shall be penalized by a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (5,000.00), or imprisonment of not less than one (1) year, or both, at the discretion of the court. If the violation is committed by a firm, partnership, corporation or other juridical entity, the manager, managing partner, trustee, director or person in-charged with the management of such firm, partnership, corporation or other judicial entity shall be held liable.*
