AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE VI, SECTION 18 OF ORDINANCE NO. 24, SERIES OF 2016 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE PASIG REVISED TRICYCLE AND PEDICAB CODE OF 2016, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as the powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective government, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the said law further emphasizes that the local government may regulate the operations of tricycle and grant of franchises for the operation thereof within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 24, Series of 2016, otherwise known as the Pasig Revised Tricycle and Pedicab Code of 2016 ("Code"), was enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod with the intention of regulating the operation of tricycle and pedicabs and providing for the guidelines for the grant of franchises for the same;

WHEREAS, in Section 18 of the Code, it provides that the City Planning Development Office ("CPDO") shall recommend to the Tricycle and Pedicab Transport Technical Working Group ("TWG") the number of motorized tricycles and pedicabs per barangay based on the ratio of 1:70;

WHEREAS, the CPDO, in its letter dated 06 September 2021 addressed to the TWG, recommends, among others, that in the absence of barangay-level data on TODAs, the tricycle and pedicab population ratio of 1:70 can be applied at the level of the city until such time that barangay-level data are established;

WHEREAS, in the absence of a concrete study and data on the basis of population ratio of 1:70 on barangay-level, amendment to the Code is necessary in order to properly accommodate the opening of franchise on a city-wide level which will serve the interest of the riding public and ensure the best benefits for the operators and drivers of the tricycles and pedicabs in the City of Pasig;



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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 18. – The amendment shall only cover the 2nd paragraph of Article VI, Section 18, which now reads:

“In no case will TORO allow registration and issuance of “for hire” motorized tricycles and pedicab in excess of the allowable ratio of 1:70 based on the city’s population. The City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) shall recommend to the TWG the number of motorized tricycles and pedicabs based on the ratio herein prescribed and to be approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.”


SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If for any reason, any section or provision of this *Ordinance* is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgement or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provision hereof.


SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. – This *Ordinance* shall take effect immediately.



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
