**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 38, SERIES OF 2020, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF PASIG TO WEAR PROPER FACE SHIELDS IN ALL ENCLOSED PUBLIC PLACES, PLACES OF WORK, COMMERCIAL AREAS, AND IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".**

**WHEREAS,** Presidential Proclamation No. 929 was issued on 16 March 2020 declaring a state of calamity throughout the Philippines due to the coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19") enjoining all government agencies and local government units to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of COVID-19;

**WHEREAS,** on 15 November 2021, the Office of the Executive Secretary issued a Memorandum with the subject, "Protocols On The Use of Face Shields", wherein it provided that the President has approved the recommendation of the IATF in its Resolution No. 148-D, Series of 2021;

**WHEREAS,** Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that local government units shall exercise powers, functions and responsibilities which are necessary, appropriate or incidental to efficient and effective for the basic services and facilities for the welfare of its constituents;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 38, SERIES OF 2020, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF PASIG TO WEAR PROPER FACE SHIELDS IN ALL ENCLOSED PUBLIC PLACES, PLACES OF WORK, COMMERCIAL AREAS, AND IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1.** – Section 1 shall now be read as:

*"The following protocols on the use of face shields shall be implemented effective immediately within the territorial jurisdiction of Pasig City:*

- 1. In case of Alert Level 5 and granular lock downs, the use of face shields in community setting shall be mandatory;*
- 2. In case of Alert Level 4, government institutions and private establishments are given discretion to mandate the use of face shields; and*
- 3. In case of Alert Levels 3, 2, and 1, the use of face shields shall be voluntary.*

*The wearing of face shields within the territorial jurisdiction of Pasig City is non-mandatory except in medical facilities such as but not limited to quarantine facilities, hospitals, clinics, and other medical institutions."*

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3.** – Section 3 shall be deleted.

**SECTION 3. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 4.** – Section 4 shall now be read:

*"It shall be unlawful for any individual to refuse the compulsory and necessary use and wearing of face shields based on the guidelines mentioned in Section 1."*

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.** – All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this *Ordinance*, or inconsistent with the regulations of this *Ordinance*, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this *Ordinance* full force and effect.

**SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** – If for any reason, any section or provision of this *Ordinance* is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgement or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provision hereof.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY.** – This *Ordinance* shall take effect immediately.




