**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 35, SERIES OF 2020 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE CITY OF PASIG VETERINARY CODE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod enacted Ordinance No. 35, Series of 2020, otherwise known as the City of Pasig Veterinary Code ("Code") for purposes of, *inter alia*, regulation on pet ownership and all aspects of animal welfare within the territorial jurisdiction of Pasig and at the same time, generating revenues for the city;

**WHEREAS**, Section 41 of the Code provides for the Registration Tag or Pet ID Microchip to each vaccinated/registered pet/companion animal, however, upon consultation and recommendation of the City of Pasig Department of Veterinary Services ("Department"), the Registration Tag has become obsolete considering that it is redundant to the issuance of Pet ID Microchip to the said pet/companion animal;

**WHEREAS**, the Department further recommends that the imposition of fees as provided in Section 60 paragraph 1 of the Code be amended, specifically the **one-time fee for Pet ID Microchip**, which will now be free of charge in order to encourage pet owners to duly register their pet/companion animals;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF PASIG IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 41.** – Section 41 of the Code is hereby amended and shall now be read as follows:

**"SECTION 41. REGISTRATION OF PET WITH RFID MICROCHIP.** – The Animal Health and Welfare Division and/or the City Pound Division of the City of Pasig Department of Veterinary Services shall issue a RFID Microchip to each vaccinated/registered pet/companion animal. Any animal found to be unregistered shall be subject to compulsory registration. The owner of any such animal shall be penalized in accordance with this Code. The Department shall devise a system wherein the issued RFID Microchip shall be traceable to the specific pet/companion animal and its owner."

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 60.** – Section 60 paragraph 1 of the Code is hereby amended and shall now be read as follows:

**"SECTION 60. ANIMAL HEALTH AND WELFARE REGULATORY FEES.**
