AN ORDINANCE CONVERTING THE PASIG CITY CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL-CHILD'S HOPE FROM A LEVEL 2 SPECIALTY HOSPITAL TO A LEVEL 2 GENERAL HOSPITAL TO BE KNOWN AS PASIG HOPE MEDICAL CENTER AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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WHEREAS, the Pasig Children's Hospital (PCCH) was created by virtue of Ordinance No. 11, Series of 2011, with the primary purpose to promote and provide globally competitive quality comprehensive health for the newborn, children and adolescents and extend psychological and moral support to their families. Set the standard for excellence and pediatric, surgery, anesthesia and allied medicine training through programs that are innovative, appropriate and responsive to the needs of Pasigueños;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Executive Order No. PCG-16, Series of 2020, dated 25 March 2020, PCCH was temporarily converted into a dedicated COVID-19 facility in order to address the increasing number of confirmed and suspected cases of COVID-19 in the city, and has since provided medical services to almost 25,000 patients;

WHEREAS, despite the temporary conversion, PCCH remains to provide medical services to adults, geriatric, pregnant and pediatric patients, among others. To aid the expansion of services, additional equipment was procured such as dialysis machines, negative pressures, and ventilators and additional personnel were hired to ensure uninterrupted delivery of medical services to the public;

WHEREAS, PCCH initially requested and applied from the Department of Health – Metro Manila Center for Health Development (MMCHD) the conversion of PCCH from a specialty hospital to a general hospital based on the Philippine Health Facility Development Plan 2020-2040;

WHEREAS, MMCHD Evaluation Committee finds the need to convert this specialty hospital to a general hospital because of the diversity and number of patients that seek treatment at the PCCH, and thereafter approved the application of the said conversion by the issuance of Certificate of Need dated 26 August 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD RESOLVES, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT:

SECTION 1. CONVERSION. – The Pasig City Children's Hospital-Child's Hope is hereby converted from a Level 2 Specialty to a Level 2 General Hospital with 120-bed capacity.

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SECTION 2. RENAMING. – The Pasig City Children's Hospital-Child's Hope is hereby renamed as Pasig Hope Medical Center.

SECTION 3. PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT. – The existing plantilla staff of the PCCH shall not be affected by the conversion of the said hospital based on the rules and regulations of the Civil Service Commission.


SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS. – The funds necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be chargeable against any available funds in the City Treasury and shall be annually be included in the Annual Appropriations Ordinance, subject to auditing rules and regulations.


SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions hereof.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.


