**AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING ELECTRIC VEHICLE USERS FROM THE MANDATORY UNIFIED VEHICULAR REDUCTION SCHEME OF THE CITY OF PASIG, AMENDING ARTICLE XXII, SECTION 133-A OF ORDINANCE NO. 23, SERIES OF 2016, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 23, Series of 2016 otherwise known as the Revised 2016 Traffic and Management Code of Pasig City (Code) provides for the traffic and parking rules and regulations for all transport vehicles operating within and traversing the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Pasig;

**WHEREAS**, Section 132 of Article XXII of the Code provides for the guidelines of Vehicular Reduction Scheme which also regulated the use of motor vehicles based on the ending of a license plate number;

**WHEREAS**, Section 133-A of the Code provides for exemptions of motor vehicles from the implementation of Vehicular Reduction Scheme in the City of Pasig provided that certain requirements and conditions are present;

**WHEREAS**, Section 25 of Republic Act No. 11697 otherwise known as the Electric Vehicle Industry Development Act (EVIDA) mandates that electric vehicle users shall enjoy non-fiscal incentives, among others, the exemption from the mandatory unified vehicle volume reduction scheme for eight (8) years from the effectivity of the said Act;

**WHEREAS**, Section 133-A of the Code needs to be amended with purposes of complying with the mandate of the EVIDA and to further encourage motor vehicle users to use electric vehicles and provide an enabling environment for the development of electric vehicles including options for micro mobility as an alternative and feasible mode of transportation to reduce dependence on fossil fuels;

**NOW, THEREFORE, ON REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD RESOLVES, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT:**

**SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** – For the purpose of the EVIDA and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, Electric Vehicle (EV) refers to a vehicle with at least one (1) electric drive propulsion, examples of which are:

1. **Battery EVs (BEVs)** are those with an electrically propelled vehicle with only a traction battery as power source for vehicle propulsion.

2. **Hybrid-EVs (HEVs)** are those with both rechargeable energy storage system and a fueled power source for propulsion.
  3. **Light EVs (LEVs)** are those EVs used in micro mobility that provide alternative modes of transportation which includes electric scooters, electric bicycles, electric personal transport, and other similar vehicles less than fifty kilograms (50kg).
  4. **Plug-in Hybrid-EVs (PHEVs)** or those EVs with rechargeable energy storage system that can be charged from an external electric energy source.

In recognition of the future advances and innovation in technologies, other EVs which may be recognized by Department of Energy: Provided, that said EV has at least one (1) electric propulsion.

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 133-A.** – Users of EVs as defined in the preceding Section shall be included in the enumerations stated in “EXEMPTED VEHICLES” and shall be itemized as letter “S”.

**SECTION 3. DURATION.** – In accordance with the EVIDA, the non-fiscal incentive of exemption of users of EVs from the mandatory unified vehicular scheme shall be eight (8) years from the effectivity of the said Act. The exemption shall automatically cease thereafter unless otherwise provided by law.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.** – All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

**SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** – If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions hereof.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY.** – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
