AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF SARI-SARI STORES IN THE CITY OF PASIG AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 132 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* has the power to impose taxes, fees, or charges to generate revenue through an appropriate ordinance;

WHEREAS, in 2017, the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* enacted Ordinance No. 51, Series of 2017, also known as the 2017 Revised Pasig Revenue Code (Code) with the primary purpose of updating the revenue code of the City Government of Pasig;

WHEREAS, Section 58 (i) of the Code provides for the imposition of tax on Sari-Sari Stores within the territorial jurisdiction of Pasig City. *Sari-sari* stores with gross sales or receipts of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000) and below are not required to secure permits from the city government, however they are subject to the local taxation in the Barangay concerned, unless they sell articles such as liquor and/or tobacco products;

WHEREAS, the Business Permit and Licensing Department recommends that *Sari-sari* stores with annual gross sales or receipts to Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P250,000) and below, regardless if they sell articles such as liquor and/or tobacco products, shall now exclusively be subject to the local taxation of the Barangay concerned with the aim of empowering the Barangays in the City and to properly administer and regulate the said trade and commerce with certain conditions established;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF PASIG, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 1. COVERAGE. – All *Sari-sari* stores with annual gross sales or receipts of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P250,000) or less, the Barangay concerned shall have the exclusive power to impose taxes and fees to the same notwithstanding the articles it sell such as liquor and/or tobacco products.

SECTION 2. REQUIREMENTS. – Applicants mentioned in the preceding Section shall submit to the Business Permit and Licensing Department (“BPLD”) the following for proper assessment:



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- Am/Ann*
- (a) Duly accomplished Unified Application Form;
 - (b) Picture of the place of business (front);
 - (c) Government-issued ID;
 - (d) Sanitary Permit;
 - (e) Health Certificate; and

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For additional requirements, to protect and promote the health of the people, to maintain an effective food regulatory system, and to provide the entire population with proper nutrition, each applicant must present the following within one (1) year from the issuance of the Special Permit:

- (f) Proof of selling food items with *Sangkap Pinoy* seal such as salt with iodine (labeled "Iodized salt") and cooking oil (labeled as "fortified with Vitamin A").

Covered establishments shall submit the requirements to the BPLD, who shall assess the eligibility of the establishment based on the start-up capital and/or gross sales and receipts, and who shall verify the completeness of the requirements, before release of the Special Permit. The Special Permit shall be valid for a period of one (1) year, and shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the premises of the store. All applicable fees to secure a Sanitary Permit and Health Certificate shall be at no cost to the covered establishments provided that it avails of the laboratory services from the City Health Department.

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE AND MONITORING. – The BPLD shall automatically process the business retirement of Sari-sari stores upon issuance of their Special Permit subject to the applicable fees as indicated in the Code. The BPLD shall inspect the *Sari-sari* store at any time during the year to determine compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance. Should the *Sari-sari* store as inspected no longer hold eligibility (per the annual gross sales or receipts), the Special Permit shall be cancelled, and the *Sari-sari* store shall be subject to the taxes and charges applicable in the 2017 Pasig City Revenue Code.

For inspection with regard to matters pertaining to the Sanitary Permit requirements and Section 2 (F) of this Ordinance, the City Health Department, through its Sanitary Unit, shall jointly inspect with the BPLD and ensure continuing compliance with the requirements.

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SECTION 4. APPLICABLE TO ALL SARI-SARI STORES. – The requirements mentioned in Section 2 (F) shall be complied with by all *Sari-sari* stores in Pasig City within one (1) year from the effectivity of this Ordinance. In case of failure to satisfy the same, the governing provisions of the 2017 Pasig City Revenue Code shall apply.



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
SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – Should any part, section, or regulation of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof other than the section or regulation so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All resolutions, ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.


SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.


