**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 40, SERIES OF 2021, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE SENIOR CITIZENS' CODE OF PASIG CITY MANDATING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF COMPREHENSIVE AND SUSTAINABLE PROGRAMS FOR THE SENIOR CITIZENS OF PASIG AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9994, known as the "Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010," declares it a policy of the State to give full support to the improvement of the total well-being of the elderly and their full participation in society considering the integral role they play in Philippine society and to motivate and encourage the senior citizens to contribute to nation building;

**WHEREAS**, the state shall advocate for programs and mechanisms, which ensure that senior citizens remain integrated in society and participate actively in the formulation and implementation of policies that directly affect their well-being;

**WHEREAS**, to promote the active participation of Senior Citizens and identify their role in policy-making, there is a need to amend Ordinance No. 40, Series of 2021, known as the Senior Citizens' Code of Pasig City;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG PASIG, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.** Sections 24, 69, 70, 71 and 72 of Ordinance No. 40, Series of 2021 are hereby amended and shall read as follows:

**"SECTION 24. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PASIG CITY SENIOR CITIZENS' COUNCIL.** Pursuant to the Department of Interior and Local Government ("DILG") Memorandum Circular No. 2014-59, there shall be an established Senior Citizens' Council who shall be primarily responsible in the formulation of policies and adoption of measures mutually beneficial to the elderly and the community.

The Pasig City Senior Citizens' Council shall be composed of the following:

- Chairperson : City Mayor
- Vice-Chairperson : City Councilor (Chairperson, Committee on Senior Citizens' Affairs)
- Executive Secretary : Head, Office of Senior Citizens' Affairs

**SECTION 69. BARANGAY SENIOR REPRESENTATIVE.** There shall be elected in every barangay one (1) senior representative who is able to communicate the concerns and positions of the seniors in their barangay. The representative must be a holder of the OSCA ID card and a resident of the barangay they will represent. They must be physically and mentally able to perform such duties as attending meetings and periodically manning the Barangay Senior Help Desk, among others.

The Barangay Senior Representative is entitled to honorarium/allowance subject to existing accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations.

**SECTION 70. BOARD OF BARANGAY SENIOR REPRESENTATIVES.** There shall be formed a recommendatory board composed of the senior representatives from the thirty (30) barangays. The board shall hold regular meetings to discuss, among others, proposed projects pertaining to the welfare of senior citizens in Pasig City and concerns of senior citizens in the different barangays.

**SECTION 71. REPRESENTATIVES TO THE PASIG CITY SENIOR CITIZENS' COUNCIL.** The Board of Barangay Senior Representatives shall elect among themselves two (2) representatives to the Senior Citizens' Council, one (1) from each district. The representatives to the Council shall participate in the creation of policies that will be beneficial to seniors and the community and shall attend the meetings of the Council as called by the Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson.

**SECTION 72. BARANGAY SENIORS' ASSOCIATION.** All duly-formed and CSO-accredited and -recognized barangay-based Senior Citizens' associations in Pasig shall be provided with the necessary information and directions to enable them to enjoy their rights and freedoms as stated in the Constitution and the laws promulgated. These associations shall take charge and coordinate for all the activities on voluntary basis."

**SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.** The funds to cover the honoraria/allowances of the barangay senior representatives shall be taken from any available funds and shall be appropriated in the annual and/or supplemental budget for each fiscal year with the approval of the City Mayor.

**SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** Should any article, section or regulation of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof other than the article, section or regulation so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, rules and regulations in conflict with or inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
