**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2, 5, AND 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 11, SERIES OF 2010 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE "TAGAMASID NG PASIG" PROJECT AS AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE ANTI-ILLEGAL DRUGS CAMPAIGN OF THE CITY, DEFINING THE COMPONENTS AND REWARDS SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF."**

**WHEREAS**, Article II, Section 22 of the Republic Act No. 9165, provides that "The Board shall recommend to the concerned government agency the grant of compensation, reward and award to any person providing information and to law enforcers participating in the operation, which results in the successful confiscation, seizure or surrender of dangerous drugs, plant sources of dangerous drugs, and controlled precursors and essential chemicals".

**WHEREAS**, Article III, Section 4 of the Dangerous Drugs Board Regulation No. 5, Series of 2003, provide that "rewards to informants who have provided timely and accurate information leading to apprehension, eradication, confiscation, or arrest of suspected drugs, trafficker, source, or dismantling of clandestine laboratories after thorough deliberation and majority vote of the Committee members meeting specifically for the purpose and further provided that there is a quorum".

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 11, Series of 2010 established the Tagamasid ng Pasig Project and defined the components, reward system, and procedures of the same.

**WHEREAS**, there is need to amend several sections of the said Ordinance to: (i) include a definition of Kush, as high-grade cannabis, which possession, sale, and use, is increasingly prevalent in the country; (ii) further define the qualifications for eligibility for the Rewards system of the Tagamasid-informant; and (iii) ensure that the Tagamasid or informant shall remain protected during the grant of the reward;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.** Section 2 of Ordinance No. 11 series of 2010 is hereby amended to include the following definition, as follows:

Sections 5 and 6 of the Ordinance, series of 2010 are hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 5. Eligibility.** Anyone (except members of PDEA, DDB, PNP, NBI, or any government agency exercising enforcement function including their relatives up to 4<sup>th</sup> degree of consanguinity and affinity) who can provide information and extend assistance to law enforcement agency that shall result in the confiscation, recovery or destruction of dangerous drugs, precursor chemicals, clandestine laboratories for illegal drugs, and marijuana plantations, including the arrest of pushers are eligible to become informants or Tagamasid in this program. They are entitled to receive commensurate rewards in accordance to the Schedule of Rewards under Section 4 of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6. Procedure.** A potential Tagamasid/informant shall fill up an Information Reporting Form (IRF) which he/she will submit (through fax or email or in person) to the person-in-charge at the Anti-Drug Abuse Council of Pasig (ADCOP) who, in turn, will give him/her a Code Name for the purpose of the project. Follow-up on action made and results concerning the submitted reports can be made through the phone, fax, email or in person using the Tagamasid/informant's assigned Code Name.

Rewards are given upon confirmation of the confiscation/recovery or destruction, as the case may be, and a case has been filed against the pusher, planter or owner. The filing of the City Prosecutor or any appropriate legal officer of the proper case in the trial court shall authorize the grant of the reward.

The grant of the reward shall be conducted in a confidential setting to ensure the safety and privacy of the Tagamasid/informant and his/her family.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
