AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE GUIDELINES FOR THE APPROVAL OF MULTI-YEAR CONTRACTS OR PROJECTS, FOR THE ISSUANCE BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF MULTI-YEAR CONTRACTUAL AUTHORITY.

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WHEREAS, Section 32, General Provisions, Republic Act No. 11936, or the General Appropriations Act of Fiscal Year 2023 ("GAA") provides:

Sec. 32. Multi-Year Contracts. The issuance of a MYCA or any similar document shall be required before agencies may enter into multi-year contracts, subject to the requirements and guidelines prescribed by the DBM: Provided, that for foreign-assisted projects funded by foreign loans, the issuance of a MYCA shall no longer be necessary.

In the case of GOCCs, x x x

For LGUs, they shall secure any equivalent document issued by their respective Sanggunian authorizing them to enter into multi-year contracts.

For the multi-year PPP projects with government undertakings authorized under R.A. No. 6957, as amended by R.A. No. 7718, x x x

In the case of recurring procurement projects such as, but not limited to, janitorial and security services, supply of drinking water, telecommunications requirements, rental of office space and equipment, and lease-purchase agreements, government agencies may either secure a MYCA or an equivalent authority or renew the ongoing contract to not more than one (1) year subject to assessment or evaluation of the contractor's performance. In no case shall the total contract renewals exceed two (2) years. Implementation of this provision shall be subject to the relevant GPPB guidelines issued thereon.

The implementing agency shall ensure that the annual funding requirements for the multi-year projects shall be included in its budget proposals for the covered years, consistent with the funding schedule in the MYCA and equivalent authorities, and letter of commitment. In the case of national government agencies and qualified GOCCs, x x x In the case of GOCCs and LGUs, due consideration shall be given by the governing board of GOCCs and the Sanggunian of the LGUs, respectively.

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In all instances, the disbursements to be incurred for multi-year contracts shall in no case exceed the cash appropriations for the purpose during the year.

Procurement of multi-year projects shall be subject to the provisions of R.A. No. 9184 and its IRR and GPPB guidelines;

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2023, the Department of Budget and Management ("DBM") issued Circular Letter No 2023-7, prescribing the "Guidelines On The Issuance Of Multi-Year Contractual Authority (MYCA)" that covers or applies to "departments, bureaus, offices, agencies and operating units of the national government, including commissions/offices under the Constitutional Fiscal Autonomy Group (CFAG) and SUCs undertaking multi-year contracts (MYCs) for locally-funded multi-year projects, including regular and recurring procurement services, except those funded by PPP and FAPs";

WHEREAS, the DBM has not, to date, issued any guidelines for the issuance of MYCA-Equivalent Documents by Governing Boards of GOCCs and by Sanggunians of Local Government Units (LGUs) as required under Section 32, General Provisions, GAA FY 2023, or under earlier similar general provisions of the GAAs for FY 2019 to FY 2022;

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2022, the City enacted Ordinance No. 31, Series of 2022 entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the Annual Budget of Pasig City for Fiscal Year 2023 in the total amount of Fifteen Billion Pesos (P15,000,000,000.00) under the General Fund for the Current Operating Expenditures and Capital Outlay requirements of the city and appropriating the necessary funds for the purpose";

WHEREAS, Section 22 of Ordinance No. 31, S. 2022, provides that:

"Section 22. MULTI-YEAR CONTRACTS. The issuance of a Multi-Year Contractual Authority (MYCA) or any similar document shall be required before entering into multi-year contracts, subject to the requirements and guidelines prescribed by the DBM. Provided that, for foreign-assisted projects funded by foreign loans, the issuance of a MYCA shall no longer be necessary.

In the procurement of projects that are already indicated in this Executive Budget as recurring and/or multi-year projects, the enactment by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the Appropriation



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Ordinance shall constitute the MYCA for said projects. For projects whose recurring nature or multi-year implementation is not indicated in the Executive Budget, a MYCA in the form of a Resolution from the Sangguniang Panlungsod authorizing the City Mayor to enter into multi-year contracts shall be secured prior to the commencement of such project.

In the case of recurring procurement projects such as, but not limited to, solid waste management services, hazardous waste management services, janitorial services, security services, supply of drinking water, telecommunications requirements, rental of office space and equipment, regular maintenance services for air-conditioning units, sewage treatment plants, elevator systems, and motor vehicles, and recurring maintenance services for software and information systems, the City may either: (i) secure a MYCA or an equivalent authority; or, (ii) renew the ongoing contract to not more than one (1) year, subject to assessment or evaluation of the contractor's performance. For projects subject of a MYCA, the total contact period, inclusive of renewals, shall not exceed three (3) years.

Procurement of recurring and/or multi-year projects shall be subject to the provisions of R.A. No. 9184, its IRR, and relevant GPPB guidelines. The end users/ implementing departments, offices, or units shall ensure that the annual funding requirements for such multi-year projects are included in their budget proposals for the covered years, consistent with the funding schedule in the MYCA or equivalent authorities, and letter of commitment. In all instances, the disbursements to be incurred for recurring and/or multi-year contracts shall not exceed the fund appropriated/obligated for the purpose during the year";

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2022, the GPPB issued Resolution No. 06-2022, "Approving the guidelines on the Renewal of Regular and Recurring Services", that became effective only on April 13, 2023, the date of its publication.

WHEREAS, GPPB Resolution No. 06-2022 applies to all government agencies including LGUs and provides the detailed guidelines for the renewal of regular and recurring services¹ for a maximum period of three (3) years, that is, one (1) year for the original contract plus two (2) one-year renewals, subject to the results of the cost-benefit analysis and performance evaluation conducted by the end-user unit;

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WHEREAS, without revising, amending, or repealing the first sentence of the second paragraph of Section 22, City Ordinance No. 31, S. 2022, that reads: "In the procurement of projects that are already indicated in this Executive Budget as recurring and/or multi-year projects, the enactment by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the Appropriation Ordinance shall constitute the MYCA for said projects.", there is a need to review the remaining provisions of the said section to ensure its consistency with the requirements of Section 32, General Provisions, GAA, FY 2023 and GPPB Resolution No. 06-2022;

WHEREAS, second sentence of the second paragraph of Section 22, City Ordinance No. 31, S. 2022, that reads: "For projects whose recurring nature or multi-year implementation is not indicated in the Executive Budget, a MYCA in the form of a Resolution from the Sangguniang Panlungsod authorizing the City Mayor to enter into multi-year contracts shall be secured prior to the commencement of such project" and, as such, the MYCA-Equivalent Document required of the City under Section 32, General Provisions, GAA, FY 2023, shall henceforth be referred to as Multi-Year Contractual Authority-Resolution or MYCA-Resolution;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32, General Provisions, GAA FY 2023, there is a need for the Sangguniang Panlungsod to revisit Section 22, Ordinance No. 31, S. 2022, that will expire in December 31, 2023, and, in its stead, enact a separate ordinance that will serve as the guidelines for its evaluation of multi-year projects and the grant of MYCA-Resolution, effective prospectively from its adoption, and thus avoid possible confusion that the guidelines become functus officio when the appropriations ordinance for the fiscal year expires;

WHEREAS, the MYCA-Resolution Guidelines of the City of Pasig shall prescribe the requirements for the application for MYCA-Resolution, the procedure for the evaluation and issuance thereof, and the procedure and evaluation criteria for the budgeting of the funding requirements of multi-year contracts subject of the MYCA-Resolution from year 2 until its completion;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod, through its Committee on Appropriations, Ways and Means and its Committee on Environmental Protection & Human Ecology, proposes the consideration and approval of this ordinance partially repealing Section 22, Ordinance No. 31, Series of 2022 by providing the herein Guidelines for the application and evaluation of multi-year projects or contracts to be procured under R.A. No. 9184 and its IRR and the grant and issuance by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of a MYCA-Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Pasig, duly assembled:



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Section 1. Title of the Ordinance: This Ordinance shall be referred to as "The Guidelines for the Approval of Multi-Year Projects, for the issuance by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Multi-Year Contractual Authority-Resolution, Revising Section 22, of City Ordinance No. 31, Series of 2022, and for other purposes." It may also be cited as the "MYCA-Resolution Guidelines".

Section 2. Objective and Coverage. The objective of this Ordinance is to revise and repeal Section 22, Ordinance No. 31, Series of 2022 to the extent herein provided, and to adopt in its stead the Guidelines herein provided.

These Guidelines shall apply to multi-year projects that require the grant and issuance by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of a MYCA-Resolution, and prior to the commencement of any early² or regular³ procurement process therefor under R.A. No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR.

These Guidelines shall apply prospectively starting Fiscal Year 2024 but shall not in any way affect, revise, modify or repeal the approvals already granted under the first sentence of the second paragraph of Section 22, Ordinance No. 31, S. 2022⁴.

2.1. These Guidelines shall apply to:

2.1.1. Specialized Goods or Equipment or Plant Facilities that require more than twelve (12) months or one (1) fiscal year to implement, complete, test, commission, and accept.

2.1.2. Support Services that, although essential to the day-to-day operations of the City, the cost of rendering the same is severely affected by frequent price fluctuations, such as the price of petroleum fuels and electricity, within the service year, thus necessitating regular contract price adjustments. Examples of these types of support services are ecological solid waste management, health care waste management, sewage/ septage management, and toxic and hazardous waste management.

2.1.3. Regular and Recurring Services that are pursued as R.A. No. 9184 Multi-Year Contracts with a maximum period of three (3) years and procured through regular procurement process and not under GPPB Resolution No. 06-2022.

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2.1.4. Multi-Year Framework Agreements for procurement in accordance with Paragraph 6.3⁵, GPPB Resolution No. 27-2019

2.1.5. Multi-Year Lease--Purchase Agreements

2.1.6. Civil Works or Infrastructure Projects that require more than twelve (12) months to implement, complete, and accept. However, the implementation to completion periods of civil works projects funded under the City Development Fund (CDF) or as Statutory Mandatory Obligations (SMOs) shall not exceed three (3) years in accordance with applicable laws, rules, and regulations.

2.1.7. Projects, such as those that are either research, scientific, or technical in nature, or consulting services with an implementation period of twelve (12) months or less but which, by design, necessitate implementation covering two (2) fiscal years.

2.2. These Guidelines shall not apply to the following projects or contracts:

2.2.1. Regular and recurring support services contracts, such as janitorial services, security services, supply of drinking water, telecommunications requirements, rental of office space and equipment, regular maintenance services for air-conditioning units, elevator systems, and motor vehicles, and recurring maintenance services for software and information systems when the original contract thereof was procured in accordance with GPPB Resolution No. 06-2022 or the GPPB Guidelines on the Renewal Of Regular And Recurring Services.

2.2.2. Subscription-based services, such as Water Supply and Electricity services, whose service providers have been granted exclusive franchises by other government agencies to operate within a specific territory, and the procurement of which shall be in accordance with Paragraph 3.1, GPPB Resolution No. 019-2006, as amended GPPB Resolution No. 03-2011 and GPPB Resolution No. 06-2022.

In the event a MYCA or equivalent document is necessary to support a contractual obligation on a multi-year basis, the procuring entity should secure such document from the relevant government authority before commencement of the relevant procurement activity in compliance with applicable law, rules, circulars, and issuances.

The issuance of MYCA shall be subject to existing budgeting and auditing rules and regulations.



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2.2.3. Projects to be procured under R.A. No. 6957 or the Build-Operate-and Transfer Law, as amended by R.A. No. 7718, and its September 2022 Revised IRR, or Joint Venture Agreements or other Public Private Partnership (PPP) arrangements under the Pasig City PPP Code.

2.3. These Guidelines shall not be interpreted as an impairment of, or limitation upon, the City Government's prerogative and discretion to pursue, develop, procure, and implement contracts and projects subject hereof under other procurement modalities available in R.A. No. 9184 and its IRR.

Section 3. Definition of Terms, Abbreviations, or Acronyms:

For the purpose of these Guidelines, the following terms, abbreviations, or acronyms shall mean as follows:

3.1. **Approved Budget for the Contract ("ABC")** - refers to the amount corresponding to the full cost of a multi-year program or project or activity, as duly approved by the City Mayor or Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE).

For lump sum allocation of a department or agency, this corresponds to the allocation of the specific implementing unit as duly approved by the City Mayor or Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE).

3.2. **Certificate of Availability of Funds ("CAF")** - refers to the certification made by the City Treasurer that is required for purposes of entering into contracts for certain types of expenditures and is an integral part of the contract. This document certifies that funds have been duly appropriated/allotted for the purpose of entering into a contract involving expenditure of public funds and that the amount necessary to cover the proposed contract for the current fiscal year is available for expenditure on account thereof, as verified by the auditor concerned, pursuant to Section 86 of Presidential Decree No. 1445.

3.3. **"GPPB"** – refers to the Government Procurement Policy Board created under Republic Act No. 9184.

3.4. **Key Performance Indicators ("KPI")** – refers to the set of specific milestones in or components of quantifiable performance measures that serve as indications of progress towards the eventual achievement of the desired performance measures.



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3.5. Minimum Performance Standards and Specifications ("MPSS") – refers to the set of minimum performance or functional standards and specifications that the supplier, service provider, contractor, or consultant shall comply with in undertaking the project or contract subject thereof.

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3.6. Multi-Year Contractual Authority - Resolution– refers to the Resolution issued by Sangguniang Panlungsod, in accordance with the provisions of Section 32, General Provisions, GAA FY 2023, as the equivalent document to a MYCA, in order to authorize the City Government to enter into multi-year contracts ("MYC") for the full project cost of multi-year programs or projects. It contains an annual breakdown of the full project cost, to ensure that agencies include in their budget proposal for the ensuing years, the amount programmed for the said years.

3.7. Multi-Year Project ("MYP") – refers to a contract, program or project that will take more than one (1) fiscal year to procure, implement and complete and thus requires multi-year appropriations.

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3.8. Multi-Year Contract ("MYC") – refers to the contract resulting from the approval, procurement, and award of MYP. It may also refer to the contract resulting from the approval, procurement, and award of a multi-year services contract that will take more than one (1) fiscal year to complete and that was not procured under GPPB Resolution No. 06-2022.

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3.9. MYCA-Resolution – refers to the document, equivalent to a Multi-Year Contractual Authority, required under Section 32, General Provisions, General Appropriations Act (GAA) of FY 2023, to be issued by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Pasig City as evidence of its conformity with the requirements of the GAA and its approval for the procurement, award of contract, and implementation of multi-year projects.

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3.10. Project - a special undertaking carried out within a definite time frame and intended to result in some predetermined measure of goods and services.

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Section 4. Guidelines

4.1. MYCA-Resolution shall be required and secured prior to commencement of any early⁶ or regular⁷ or procurement activity relative to the Multi-Year Contracts (MYC) for Multi-Year Projects (MYP). The total project cost reflected in the MYCA-Resolution shall be the basis or reference for the ABC, required under R.A. No. 9184 and its Revised IRR. Meanwhile, the annual breakdown indicated in the MYCA-Resolution shall be the basis for the issuance of the CAF per year of implementation.

The funding requirements of the MYC or MYP from Year 2 until its completion, for which the MYCA-Resolution was issued by the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall be included in the City's expenditure program for every corresponding year.

The Template MYCA-Resolution is hereto attached as **Form No. 1**. The Sangguniang Panlungsod reserves the right to regularly review and modify this template form.

4.2. MYCA-Resolution shall be issued for projects that are research, scientific, or technical in nature or consulting services with implementation period of twelve (12) months or less which by design, necessitates implementation covering two (2) fiscal years.

4.3. The End-User/Implementing Department, Office, or Unit of the City Government shall submit the following documentary requirements when requesting for the issuance of a MYCA-Resolution from the Sangguniang Panlungsod:

4.3.1. Request for the Issuance of a MYCA-Resolution. A budget proposal submitted to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, whether by way of the Executive Budget, or Supplemental Budget, to support a multi-year project (MYP) as defined herein shall be accompanied by a Request for the Issuance of a MYCA-Resolution and its supporting project documents.

The template request for the issuance of a MYCA-Resolution is hereto provided as **Form No. 2**. As it may deem necessary, the Sangguniang Panlungsod reserves the right to regularly review, update, and modify Template Form No. 2.

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4.3.2. Certification that no procurement has been commenced.

Certification of the City Mayor that no early or regular procurement activity, such as posting of the bid opportunity, pertaining to the project to be covered by the MYCA-Resolution has been commenced or started as of date of request.

When the MYP is being proposed as part of the Executive Budget and for inclusion in the appropriations ordinance, this requirement may be incorporated in the endorsement of the City Mayor that accompanies the submission of the proposed executive budget to the Sangguniang Panlungsod. This requirement shall also be complied with when the proposed MYP is submitted (a) by way of supplemental budget or (b) for conversion of a project or contract from an approved single-year project or contract under annual cash-based budgeting to multi-year project or contract.

4.3.3. Justification in support of the Request for MYCA-Resolution.

This may include a comparative analysis between pursuing the proposed project or contract under Single-Year Term and as against Multi-Year Term, upon, among others, the following aspects:

- 4.3.3.1 Project/contract planning, budgeting, procurement, delivery, and completion which may include a discussion on why the project or contract is best pursued under multi-year basis and not as a single year, or phased procurement and implementation, or as a regular and recurring service.
- 4.3.3.2 Minimum Performance Standards and Specifications ("MPSS") or Key Performance Indicators ("KPIs") that may be prescribed for the proposed MYP.
- 4.3.3.3 Diligence in complying with contractual obligations.
- 4.3.3.4 Performance Evaluation
- 4.3.3.5 Such other relevant aspects

4.3.4. MPSS or KPIs for the proposed MYP or MYC

4.3.5. Terms of Services for Service contracts or Program of Work for civil works projects proposed as MYP.

4.3.6. Proposed Project or Contract Implementation Schedule and establishing its correlation with the proposed MPSS or KPIs.



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4.3.7. Proposed Total Project Cost, broken down to reflect the budgetary requirements per year of implementation, with relevant assumptions or projections used in the derivation thereof. These relevant assumptions or projections used to derive the total and annual project costs, such as the cost of petroleum fuels or of electricity, shall, as much as possible, be based on government price monitoring indices for said fluctuating variable costs or parameters of the project or contract.

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4.3.8. Proposed Performance Evaluation Criteria

4.3.9. When applicable, disclosure of other government permits, licenses, or clearances required under existing laws, policies, rules, and regulations that may impact project procurement, implementation, or completion. Examples: DICT endorsed ISSP for ICT projects, NTC clearance for acquisition of communication equipment, DENR geo-hazard certification; or Project Location with geo-tagged mapping or electronic photograph of the project location with certification, etc.

4.3.10. Other relevant aspects of the proposed MYP or contract

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4.4. The Sangguniang Panlungsod hereby pilots and provides, as Annex A hereof, the checklist of documentary requirements for the grant and issuance of MYCA-Resolution for the procurement of Garbage Collection and Hauling Services.

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The Sangguniang Panlungsod may, by resolution, subsequently issue and annex to this Ordinance the checklist of documentary requirements for the issuance of a MYCA-Resolution for other types of MYCs or MYPs, such as, but not limited to civil works or infrastructure projects, healthcare waste management, septage management, toxic or hazardous waste management, and projects that are research or scientific in nature.

Applications for MYCA-Resolution for multi-year framework agreements shall comply with the requirements prescribed under GPPB Resolution No. 27-2019.

4.5. The Sanggunian shall grant multi-year contractual authorization for a given calendar year to projects for which all requisite procurement requirements have been submitted during the first quarter of the same calendar year.

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4.6. Additional Guidance:

Notwithstanding the issuance of a MYCA-Resolution, MYCs entered into based on such MYCA-Resolution, shall further be guided by the following:

4.6.1. The multi-year contract End-User, Implementing Unit, or Project Management Office of the City Government should conduct an annual review thereon to enable it to negotiate for a lower price for the service in the event that the actual cost for the goods or services covered by the contract becomes lower per prevailing market analysis;

4.6.2. The multi-year contract End-User, Implementing Unit, or Project Management Office of the City Government shall ensure that the annual funding requirements for the MYCs for which MYCA-Resolutions have been issued are included in their respective Procurement Project Management Plans (PPMPs), in the APP, and in line with their budget proposals, and in the Executive Budget Proposal to be submitted to Sangguniang Panlungsod for the covered years, consistent with the funding schedule in the MYCA-Resolutions.

When submitting the budget proposal for the annual funding requirement for year 2, and every year thereafter until its completion year, of the MYC for which a MYCA-Resolution has been issued, the Executive Budget Proposal to the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall be supported by the following documents relative to each MYC:

4.6.2.1. Contract or Project Implementation Update Report, that shall cover, among others, the status of implementation, levels of service or accomplishments, delays or challenges encountered and how these were addressed or resolved, and violations and penalties, if any, imposed upon the supplier, service provider, contractor, or consultant during that period.

4.6.2.2. Performance Evaluation Report on the supplier, service provider, contractor, or consultant, based on the performance evaluation criteria presented during the application process for the MYCA-Resolution and reflected in the bidding documents and executed contract.

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4.6.2.3. Amount and justification for the proposed for funding for the budget year. The justification shall cover, among others:

- An analysis on the variable costs, such as cost of petroleum products or electricity, or the variable levels of service cited as the reason behind the application for MYCA-Resolution and upon which it was granted.
- Projected contract or project implementation schedule for the budget year, including, catch-up programs or advance works or services.
- When applying for budget for the funding requirements for the target completion year of a multi-year service contract, the proposed early procurement schedule shall also be submitted.
- As a general rule, the project funding requirements for year 2 until completion year as reflected in the MYCA-Resolution operate as a budget ceiling. As such, verifiable and compelling reasons or justifications shall be presented to explain why said projected funding requirements exceed the budget ceiling.

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The Sangguniang Panlungsod hereby pilots and provides, as **Annex A-1** hereof, the checklist of documentary requirements for the budget proposal for Year 2 and subsequent years for the implementation multi-year Garbage Collection and Hauling Services.

4.6.3. In all instances, disbursements to be incurred in any given year shall in no case exceed the cash program for the purpose during the year.

For MYCs or MYPs, the CAF shall be issued annually based on the budget for the year.

For MYCs or MYPs with no funding requirement on any given year, the City Treasurer's Office shall issue -- instead of CAF - a certification that no fund is needed for the year, as indicated in the approved MYCA-Resolution;

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4.6.4. Procurement of multi-year projects shall be subject to the provisions of R.A. No. 9184 and its IRR, as amended, and GPPB guidelines and/or the DBM.

4.6.5. In the interest of proper disclosure and efficient procurement processes, the end-user or implementing departments, offices, units of MYCs or MYPs as well as the City's Bids and Awards Committee ("BAC") shall ensure that the information relevant to the procurement process, project budgeting and funding method, contract implementation and management, and performance evaluation, of the MYC or MYP for which a MYCA-Resolution has been issued by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, are:

(a) incorporated in the relevant or appropriate portions of the appropriate Philippine Bidding Documents (PBD), such as the Bid Data Sheet, Eligibility Data Sheet (for consulting services), Special Conditions of Contract, and Technical Requirements; and

(b) properly explained to the prospective bidders and interested stakeholders during the pre-bid conference and, if necessary, clarified by way of bid bulletins.


Section 5. Separability Clause. If for any reason any portion or provision of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions thereof which are not shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 6. Repealing Clause. Except for its 2nd paragraph, Section 22 of City Ordinance No. 31, Series of 2022 is hereby repealed.

Section 7. Effectivity Clause. This ordinance shall take effect within ten (10) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Pasig City.
