AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING CLEANLINESS PRACTICES IN THE CITY OF PASIG, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates local government units (LGUs) to ensure the promotion of health and safety, enhancement of the right of the people to a balanced ecology, maintenance of peace and order, and preservation of the comfort of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 458 of the Local Government Code empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to adopt measures for the protection of the environment and inhabitants of the City from the harmful effects of disasters and calamities, including the implementation of effective systems on waste collection and disposal, as well as prohibitions on littering and careless throwing of garbage;

WHEREAS, Clean as You Go (CLAYGO) is a waste management practice which encourages individuals to clean up after themselves and keep spaces clean after they have utilized them to minimize risks to hygiene, health, and safety;

WHEREAS, "Tapat Ko, Linis Ko" is a cleanliness practice locally popularized and implemented by other LGUs which encourages the public to maintain the cleanliness and orderliness of the immediate surroundings of their own properties or dwelling places;

WHEREAS, protection of the environment and maintenance of the ecological balance are responsibilities that are not to be left solely to the government, but require the collective efforts of the members of society as well;

WHEREAS, community participation in normalizing cleanliness and orderliness practices such as CLAYGO and Tapat Ko, Linis Ko creates a greater positive impact in safeguarding and sustaining the world we live in by avoiding reliance on street sweepers, city cleaners, janitors, wait staff and the like, and ultimately instilling cleanliness as a community value;

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING CLEANLINESS PRACTICES IN THE CITY OF PASIG, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, measures to strengthen cleanliness and sanitation in Pasig City will not only affect the environment, but also promote the protection of health, and social and moral welfare of Pasigueños as we institutionalize these practices as part of our daily routines;

WHEREAS, the institutionalization of specific cleanliness and orderliness practices are consistent with the purpose and intent of already existing Codes of the City Government, specifically (1) Chapters VIII, XI, and XIV of Pasig City Ordinance No. 18, Series of 2018, or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Code of Pasig City; (2) Chapters VII and XV of Pasig City Ordinance No. 15, Series of 2008 or the Sanitation Code of Pasig City; and (3) Chapter 15 of Pasig City Ordinance No. 35, Series of 2020 or the City of Pasig Veterinary Code, and shall supplement their implementation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "CLAYGO and Tapat Ko, Linis Ko Ordinance of Pasig City."

SECTION 2. CLEAN AS YOU GO (CLAYGO). –

(a) All owners and/or managers of fast-food establishments, food stalls or kiosks, canteens, coffee shops, food trucks, concession stands, and other similar quick service food establishments located within Pasig City shall institutionalize measures and programs to encourage their customers to practice Clean as You Go (CLAYGO), which shall include:

- (i) installation of signages and other materials on CLAYGO within the premises of their establishment;
- (ii) promotion and utilization of reusable materials such as cloth bags, in furtherance of Pasig City Ordinance No. 9, Series of 2010;
- (iii) designation of a repository area for tray returns and other non-disposable tableware; and
- (iv) provision of appropriate garbage bins which are compliant with the waste segregation regulations of the City under Pasig City Ordinance No. 18, Series of 2018, or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Code of Pasig City.

Full-service restaurants and similar restaurants where customers are seated and waited on by service staff and/or collect additional charges for services rendered are exempted from the coverage of this Section.

(b) Consistent with the prohibition on littering, throwing, and dumping of waste matters and debris of whatever form in public places under the Ecological Solid Waste Management Code of Pasig City, all individuals shall practice **CLAYGO** in the use of public spaces owned by the Pasig City Government, such as parks, markets, roads, sidewalks, multipurpose facilities, and the like.

SECTION 3. TAPAT KO, LINIS KO. –

(a) All owners, tenants and/or occupants of housing units, residential, and commercial establishments located within Pasig City shall be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of any public space, including walkways, sidewalks, alleyways, streets, and/or roads, immediately surrounding their owned or occupied property.

(b) To facilitate the implementation of this Section, the following acts are hereby prohibited:

- (i) Hanging of clothes and other effects on electrical wires, posts, and other public places or structures not intended for that purpose;
- (ii) Washing and drying of clothes along walkways, sidewalks, streets, alleyways, and/or roads;
- (iii) Leaving animal waste outside the boundaries of private property;
- (iv) Storing, dumping, or placing wastes, debris, dilapidated or junked items, and other similar objects in public spaces; and
- (v) Construction or installation of animal cages or pens, or leaving pets on a leash outside the boundaries of private property.

(c) Temporary use of any public walkways, sidewalks, alleys, streets, roads, bridges, parks, or other public places for a definite period shall require a special permit from the Sangguniang Barangay or City Government.

SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATIVE FINES. – Any natural or juridical person found in violation of Sections 2(a) and 3(b) of this Ordinance shall be issued a Notice of Violation and subjected to the payment of the following administrative fines:

Offense	Natural Person	Juridical Person
First Offense	One Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,000.00)	Two Thousand Pesos (PhP 2,000.00)
Second Offense	Two Thousand Pesos (PhP 2,000.00)	Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 3,500.00)
Third and Subsequent Offenses	Three Thousand Pesos (PhP 3,000.00)	Five Thousand Pesos (PhP 5,000.00)

The administrative fines payable to the City Government of Pasig shall be directed to the General Fund of the City and shall be used for the implementation of its cleanliness and sanitation programs.

SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES. –The City Environmental and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) and the Solid Waste Management Office (SWMO) shall be primarily responsible for ensuring the proper implementation of and monitoring compliance of the public with this Ordinance.

Those identified as Regular Enforcers and Auxiliary Enforcers under Sections 36 and 37 of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Code of Pasig City are hereby deputized to enforce this Ordinance in the same capacity provided to them under the aforementioned Code.


SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, resolutions, orders, circulars and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. – This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its posting at the entrance of the Pasig City Hall and in two (2) other conspicuous places in the City for three (3) consecutive weeks and its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation.


