AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE "BAHAY NG BAGONG BUHAY" UNDER THE PASIG CITY ANTI-DRUG ABUSE OFFICE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Pasig City Government has to properly establish the "Bahay ng Bagong Buhay" which functions as temporary shelter for drug dependents, currently under the supervision of the Pasig City Anti-Drug Abuse Office (PCADAO);

WHEREAS, the "Bahay ng Bagong Buhay" temporary shelter, in addition, provides interim accommodations for people who are seriously drug dependent while pursuing rehabilitation to transform themselves into self-sustaining, law-abiding citizens;

WHEREAS, the "Bahay ng Bagong Buhay" temporary shelter, will serve as a holding facility for drug dependents caused by the dangerous drug abuse as one of the worst social ills that humanity needs to address as it distorts one's judgment, destroys one's life and eventually, ruins the drug-afflicted victim's family;

WHEREAS, the "Bahay ng Bagong Buhay" will cater to drug personalities who can enter the rehabilitation program like those who voluntarily surrendered, Section 15 (Use of Dangerous Drugs) under Republic Act No. 9165 and are required to undergo Drug Reformation Program serving as an alternate intervention, and those who served jail terms for violation of the said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD RESOLVES, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT:

SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF BAHAY NG BAGONG BUHAY. – It is hereby established the Bahay ng Bagong Buhay under the PCADAO that will

serve as temporary shelter to drug dependent individuals recommended by the accredited physician to undergo treatment and rehabilitation program while securing the following requirements before admission to Department of Health (DOH) Accredited Treatment and Rehabilitation Centers:

A. Before Admission to "Bahay ng Bagong Buhay" Temporary Shelter

1. Intake Interview (Petitioner: Family Member: Parents, Children, Husband, Wife)
2. Petitioner will submit the xerox copy of the Intake Interview form and the original copy of the initial requirements to PCADAO.
3. Application for Court Clearance of the Patient
4. Pick-up of patient

Admission to "Bahay ng Bagong Buhay" Temporary Shelter

1. Patient will undergo Drug Dependency Examination (DDE)
2. Patient will undergo Medical Examination
3. Application for Court Order
4. Admission to Rehabilitation Center

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF PCADAO. – the PCADAO shall be in-charge in reforming the drug dependents and giving programs on:

A. General Interventions but not limited to the following:

- 1. Education and Health**
 - a. Knowledge on Illegal Drugs
 - b. Ill Effects of Illegal Drugs
 - c. Lecture on Republic Act No. 9165
- 2. Psychological/Spiritual/Physical Activities**
 - a. Counseling/Consultative Meetings
 - b. Moral Recovery Activities
 - c. Values Formulation
 - d. Personal and Life Skills
 - e. Community Service
 - f. Exercises and Sports Activities

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All orders or portions of orders in conflict with this Ordinance, or inconsistent with the regulations of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or invalid by competent court, such judgement or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions hereof.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
