WHEREAS, Art. XIV, Sec. 10 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "Science and technology are essential for national development and progress. The State shall give priority to research and development, invention, innovation, and their utilization; and to science and technology education, training, and services. It shall support indigenous, appropriate, and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities and their application to the country's productive systems and national life";

WHEREAS, one of the means to achieve the goal of the aforesaid provision is by strengthening, enhancing and advancing the teaching skills of science teachers in public schools within its Division resulting to excellence in the learners' performance in their Science subjects;


Background

The hearing was conducted in order to present, discuss/comment, generate agreements on amendments (if any) on two resolutions named in paragraphs A and B below. These resolutions were approved on first reading and referred to this committee for appropriate action during the July 28, 2022 regular session.

Discussion and Recommendation of Each of the Two Resolutions

Under the title of each resolution is the presentation of relevant comments and recommendations to wit:

- A. A resolution requiring the presence of a Sign Language interpreter during the flag ceremony being held every Monday morning at the Pasig City Hall.**

Discussion

The meeting acknowledged the importance of the resolution thus the discussion revolved around issues of (1) merit, (2) feasibility, (3) accuracy of time attribution, (4) availability of qualified sign language interpreters currently and in the near future, (5) how to make the proposal wider in scope and reach more audience and stakeholders even beyond the present deaf persons, and (6) technical requirements to improve the quality of viewing and reach of the proposed activity.

Recommendations

After a thorough discussion of the above items, the following amendments were proposed on the original version of the resolution:

Title: A Resolution **Highly Encouraging** ~~Requiring~~ the Presence of a Sign Language Interpreter During the Flag **Raising** Ceremony Being Held ~~Every Monday Morning~~ **at the Beginning of Each Work Week** at the Pasig City Hall.

(Words in red font are the recommended changes and the struck through words are recommended to be deleted)

Body of the resolution

All WHEREASES are to be retained without amendment

The following paragraphs for amendment with changes indicated in red font.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, this Sangguniang Panlungsod resolves, to **highly encourage** the presence of a sign language interpreter during the Flag **raising** ceremony **at the beginning of each work week** at the Pasig City Hall.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Cultural Affairs and Tourism Office (CATO) and the Special Children Education Institute of Pasig City shall be held responsible for the implementation **and together with the Pasig Information Office will exercise due diligence in promoting this resolution to a larger audience and improving higher standards of quality in all aspects of the practice.**


B. A Resolution Authorizing the City Government of Pasig Through the Honorable City Mayor Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto to Enter and Sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Education Schools Division Office Pasig City and Pontifical and Royal University of Santo Tomas College of Education for the Scholarship Grant of the City Government of Pasig to Selected Secondary Junior and Senior High School Science Teachers within the City of Pasig, and For Other Purposes.

Discussion

The proposed program of scholarship was explained thoroughly by Mr. Rechie Tugawin and amplified by Dr. Liza Alvarez who is the main proponent from SDO

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and served as the principal negotiator with UST officials for the different items in the Terms of Reference of the proposed Memorandum of Agreement.

The Question and Answer portion of the discussion revolved around specific components of the certificate program as well as competencies, strategies, pedagogy, content and platform of delivery. All these were patiently and satisfactorily responded to by the resource persons from UST. In addition there were out of the usual components of a curriculum in an academic setting like encouraging the conduct of research for publication purposes, being part of Group Chat created for the class up to two years or even after the 6-months program

In summary, the committee members were convinced that the scholarship program as proposed will be beneficial to the 153 proposed recipient science teachers, if implemented as designed.

Recommendations

There is a slight recommendation in the title as follows: Delete secondary because it duplicates High School; Add Public; for public teachers only.



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement entered into this _____ day of _____, 2022 in the City of Pasig, among the:

LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT – PASIG CITY with principal office address at Caruncho Avenue, Brgy. San Nicolas, Pasig City, represented in this Agreement by its City Mayor, **VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO**, and hereinafter, referred to as "**Pasig City**";

-and-

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE PASIG CITY, with principal address at Caruncho Avenue, San Nicolas Pasig City represented herein by its Officer-in Charge, Office of the Schools Division Superintendent, **MA. EVALOU CONCEPCION A. AGUSTIN** and hereinafter, referred to as "**SDO Pasig**".

-and-

PONTIFICAL AND ROYAL UNIVERSITY OF SANTO TOMAS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, with principal address at España Blvd., Sampaloc, Manila represented herein by **VERY REV. FR. RICHARD G. ANG, O.P., Ph. D.**, and hereinafter, referred to as "**UST**".

Collectively referred to as the "**Parties**".

WITNESSETH, that:

would help in advancing, enhancing, and strengthening teaching skills of Science teachers in public schools;

WHEREAS, SDO Pasig desires its public school Science High School teachers to undergo said Program from UST;

WHEREAS, Pasig City, a staunch advocate for quality education has offered to provide public school Science High School teachers, with scholarship for UST's Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, Parties hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

I. Scope

This Agreement shall cover the of scholarship grant of Pasig City to selected secondary junior and senior high school Science teachers within the city, who are qualified to undergo a content and skills enhancement course leading to a Certificate in Science Teaching Program at UST.

II. Responsibilities of SDO Pasig

SDO Pasig shall be responsible for the following:

1. Carefully screen teacher-applicants for the scholarship Program and make the corresponding recommendation to **Pasig City**.
2. Endorse to UST the name of Pasig City's approved list of Teacher-Scholars, who would undergo the admission process of the said university.
3. Monitor the academic advancement of Teacher-Scholars through its Curriculum and Implementation Division (CID).
4. Coordinate with the UST Focal Person on various issues and concerns relative to the Program.
5. Report to Pasig City the progress of Teacher-Scholars as well as the name of Teacher-Scholars who have successfully completed the Program.
6. Conduct a program evaluation together with UST and submit the same to Pasig City.

III. Responsibilities of Pasig City

1. Allocate funds from the Special Education Fund of Fiscal Year 2022 to cover for the tuition, miscellaneous, graduation and other school fees of the Teacher-Scholars.
2. Pay Fifty Percent (50%) of the tuition and miscellaneous fees subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations upon receipt from UST of the billing statement containing the enrollment details of the Teacher-Scholars.

3. Pay the remaining Fifty Percent (50%) of the tuition, miscellaneous, graduation and other school fees subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations one month before the end of the Program.

4. Coordinate with SDO Pasig on the progress of the Teacher-Scholars.

IV. Responsibilities of UST

UST shall be responsible for the following:

1. Evaluate the entrance credentials of prospective students as recommended by SDO Pasig and Pasig City.

2. Accept Teacher-Scholars with complete admission requirements for the Program.

3. Conduct the Program *via* Hybrid mode, with selected sessions done through in-person and/or on-site basis.

4. Assign an Adviser for the Teacher-Scholars.

5. Confer the post baccalaureate degree of Certificate in Science Teaching Program to Teacher-Scholars, who have passed all their subjects and completed all the requirements of UST.

6. Conduct a program evaluation together with SDO Pasig and submit the same to Pasig City.

V. Program Period

The Program shall be a Twenty Seven (27) unit course within a period of six (6) months starting from August 2022 and ending on January 2023.

VI. Data Privacy

Parties agree to abide and comply with all the requirements of R.A. No. 10173, popularly known as the “**Data Privacy Act of 2012**”, its Implementing Rules and Regulations as well as issuances of the National Privacy Commission.

VII. Effectivity

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect upon signing by the Parties and shall remain in effect for a period of _____ from _____ until _____.
