WHEREAS, Rule 18, Sections 1 and 2 of Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, mandates Local Government Units (LGUs) to set aside not less than five percent (5%) of their estimated revenue from regular resources for the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund (LDRRMF), otherwise known as the Calamity Fund;

WHEREAS, Section 21 of Republic Act No. 10121 states that, "upon the recommendation of the LDRRMO and approval of the sanggunian concerned, the LDRRMC may transfer the said fund to support disaster risk reduction work of other LDRRMCs which are declared under state of calamity";

WHEREAS, based on Sanggunian Resolution No. 180, Series of 2022, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Abra declared a State of Calamity in the Province of Abra due to the massive destruction caused by the 7.3-magnitude earthquake that struck the province on 27 July 2022, with the Municipality of Lagangilang, Abra as the epicenter;

WHEREAS, the Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (PCDRRMO) recommends to the Pasig City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (PCDRRMC), through its Chairman, Honorable City Mayor Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto, that financial assistance be extended to provinces most affected by calamities using the 2018 Special Trust Fund;

WHEREAS, the financial assistance shall provide temporary respite to the affected LGUs in times of great distress, while in the process of recovery and rehabilitation;



WHEREAS, based on official record of the PHILVOCS, a magnitude 7.3 earthquake struck the whole province of Abra where the municipality of Lagangilang, Abra was its epicenter;

WHEREAS, initial/progressing report from PDRRMO on damages caused by the earthquake have affected eighty percent (80%) of the total population of Abra and major infrastructure facilities

both private and government properties were severely damaged as shown in the hereto attached Consolidated Damages Report by the PDRRMO, marked as ANNEX "A";

WHEREAS, such a disaster has destroyed power lines placing Abra into province wide brown out and the destruction of houses, buildings and bridges have paralyzed the operation of business establishments likewise, displacing a lot of Abranios as they stay out of their homes without food;

WHEREAS, in order for the Provincial Government of Abra to immediately address the needs of the people in the aftermath of the earthquake, it is imperative to declare the entire province of Abra under a State of Calamity;

NOW THEREFORE, in Special Session duly assembled, be it-

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to declare the Province of Abra under a State of Calamity to mobilize the Provincial and the 27 LGUs to respond to the immediate needs of Abrenios and for other purposes:

RESOLVED FURTHER, commitment to this destruction the 5% Calamity Reserve Fund is available and authorized to be utilized for the purpose and for other related purposes;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to request immediate assistance from all National Government Agencies for Disaster response, relief, rehabilitation and reconstruction support;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution to the Office of the President, NDRRMC, DSWD, DPWH, DOH and other concerned agencies.
