A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE WILDCAT SIKARAN – PASIG FOR WINNING SEVEN (7) GOLD MEDALS, ELEVEN (11) SILVER MEDALS, AND TEN (10) BRONZE MEDALS, THEREBY EMERGING AS THE OVERALL CHAMPION OF THE 1ST INVITATIONAL SIKARAN TOURNAMENT HELD ON 18 FEBRUARY 2023 AT MANDALUYONG CITY.

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 (1) of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that “[t]he State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;

WHEREAS, on 18 February 2023 at Mandaluyong City, the Wildcat Sikaran – Pasig of the Global Sikaran Federations, Inc., competed in the 1st Invitational Sikaran Tournament – a Filipino martial arts competition participated in by seven (7) cities from the National Capital Region (NCR) and Region IV-A (CALABARZON);

WHEREAS, after the competition, the Wildcat Sikaran – Pasig garnered a total of twenty-eight (28) medals, specifically seven (7) gold medals, eleven (11) silver medals, and ten (10) bronze medals – and was thus proclaimed the overall champion of the said tournament;

WHEREAS, the following team members won silver medals, namely: Elijah Bautista, Princess Chloe Ebit, Max Jaden Castro, Patrick Pattong, Steven Jamir Adalla, Ivan James Borrás, Ronel Castro, Dana Jane Afable, Elhaira Marie Calino, Keila Reign Paligutan and Rogelaine Samantha Gelacio;

WHEREAS, the following team members won bronze medals, namely: Rhoanne Cate Pica, Sanden Mark Gonzales, Elijah Bautista, William Charles Bulat-ag, Darrel John Afable, Davy Jones Villagauan, John Raven Borrás and Patrick Pattong;

WHEREAS, the team also won a gold medal and two (2) bronze medals in the Biakid Event, for the Biakid King and Biakid Queen categories, respectively;

WHEREAS, the athletes of Wildcat Sikaran – Pasig, as well as their coaches and chief instructor, Master German R. Patingo, deserve the praise and recognition for the excellence they exhibited in the tournament, and for serving as sources of inspiration for their fellow athletes in the field of martial arts;
