A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF PASIG, THROUGH HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OF TANAY, RIZAL, TO SUPPORT THE RELOCATEE-FAMILIES FROM PASIG CITY WHO ARE RESIDING IN THREE (3) NHA RELOCATION SITES IN TANAY, RIZAL, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig and Municipal Government of Tanay, in partnership with the National Housing Authority (NHA) developed three (3) relocation sites in Barangay Plaza Aldea, Tanay, Rizal, known as "NHA SOUTHVILLE 10", "EASTSHINE RESIDENCES", and "HAUZVILLE";

WHEREAS, the said partnership was conceived for the purpose of providing a relocation area for the informal settler families from the City of Pasig affected by the clearing of waterways and other danger areas pursuant to a Supreme Court mandamus. Likewise, said relocation sites accommodates the transfer of informal settler families from the host Municipality of Tanay, Rizal who are affected by the clearing of waterways and other danger areas in that municipality;

WHEREAS, it was the generosity of the Municipality of Tanay that made possible the development of the said relocation sites when they accepted and allowed its implementation in their municipality. More so, when they declared that only Pasig City and the municipality's residents will be accepted in the said relocation area;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Municipal Government of Tanay, Rizal to grant assistance in providing basic services, including salaries/allowances to personnel involved in security, sanitation, health, school and day care and livelihood trainers, to Pasigueños families to be relocated to the three relocation areas in the latter, namely, NHA Southville 10, Eastshine Residences and Hauzville;

WHEREAS, effectivity periods of the Memorandum of Agreements between the Pasig City Government and the Municipal Government of Tanay, Rizal for Southville 10 and the Eastshine Residences shall lapse on December 31, 2022, and that for Hauzville, the Memorandum of Agreement has long expired on November 2021.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig expresses its willingness to continue extending assistance to the said relocation sites as stated in Section 16 and 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991, for the benefit and welfare of the relocatee -Pasig City residents. It also looks forward in the few years to come to the full integration of the Pasig City relocatees into the governmental system of the Municipality of Tanay via transfer of voter's registration and provision of basic services.



Sotto, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the Municipality of Tanay, Rizal, to support the relocatee-families from Pasig City who are residing in three (3) NHA relocation sites in Tanay, Rizal.


