A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, VICTOR MA. REGIS N. SOTTO TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO TWO HUNDRED (200) AFFECTED POOR AND UNDERPRIVILEGED FAMILIES OF THE FIRE INCIDENT AT ESGUERRA ST., BRGY. PINAGBUHATAN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code ("code") provides that, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the same code provides that, the City has the duties and responsibility of constructing infrastructure facilities intended primarily to service the needs of its residents including the construction of roads, multi-purpose buildings, housing facilities, among others;

WHEREAS, Section 28 of Republic Act 7279 otherwise known as the Urban Development and Housing Act and Section 14 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 10752 or the Right of Way Act, provides that the City has the duty to provide housing relocation whether permanent or temporary to affected families or its monetary equivalent, among others;

WHEREAS, the two hundred (200) poor and underprivileged families are located at Esguerra St., Brgy. Pinagbuhatan, were victims of the fire incident last 11 April 2023;

WHEREAS, the said informal settler families have been duly validated by the Pasig Urban Settlements Office (PUSO) together with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO), as poor and underprivileged and, as defined by the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA);

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) on its **Spot Report** dated 12 April 2023 has contemplated the involved area as consisting of only one (1) entry and exit; BFP further stated that the pathways through the houses inside the compound were congested and this type of place is considered a **fire trap** making fire suppression operation extremely difficult, thus necessitating the redevelopment of the area before residents may safely return to the area;

WHEREAS, as a result of the aforementioned reasons, these informal settler families will be displaced for a period of time at least six (6) months as the city government takes the necessary actions to redevelop the said area;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig shall provide financial assistance in the amount of Six Thousand Pesos (Php6,000.00) per month as rental subsidy for six (6) months for each of the sixty-seven (67) affected **structure owners** listed below:
