WHEREAS, it is declared a policy of the state as prescribed in Republic Act No. 9520, known as the Philippine Cooperative Code of 2008, to foster the creation and growth of cooperatives as a practical vehicle for promoting self-reliance and harnessing people power towards the attainment of economic development and social justice;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Pasig recognizes the importance of the Pasig City Cooperative Development Council (PCCDC) in pursuing the state policy at the local level and has seen it fit to create the Council within the City of Pasig under Ordinance No. 37 series of 1996 and strengthening it and its function under Ordinance No. 10 series of 2017;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod acknowledges the need to revitalize the Pasig City Cooperative Development Council to empower it to achieve the aforesaid state policy by the provision of Funding Requirements in Section 14, Ordinance No. 10 series of 2017;

WHEREAS, it has been customary for the thousands of Cooperators in Pasig City, under the joint leadership of the Pasig City Cooperative Development Council (PCCDC), the Cooperative Development Office (CDO) and the Samahan ng mga Kooperatiba sa Pasig (SAKOP) with the support of the City Government of Pasig to organize and conduct various activities designed to highlight the role of Cooperatives in Community Development and to foster and strengthen the Pasig City Cooperative Sector.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Pasig resolves as it hereby resolves to authorize the Honorable City Mayor Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto to grant financial assistance in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 500,000.00) to the Pasig City Cooperative Development Council for its plans and programs.







Salient Points Discussed:

- Financial assistance to the Pasig City Cooperative Development Council will be used for plans and activities related to the celebration of Cooperative Month, among others. The Cooperative Development Office, PCCDC and SAKOP (Samahan ng mga Kooperatiba sa Pasig) collaborate to undertake these activities for a participative and inclusive cooperative sector.
- Support to the cooperative sector and its initiatives is vital as cooperatives play an important role in economic growth and post-pandemic economic recovery.
- While the contribution of cooperatives to the local economy has gone unmeasured in the past, there are steps being taken on a national level to conduct a social impact audit of the cooperative sector.
- The City Budget Office OIC confirmed that the financial assistance is included in the AIP and Budget of CDO.






