WHEREAS, Article II, Section 23 of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall encourage non-governmental, community-based, or sectoral organizations that promotes the welfare of the nation;

WHEREAS, Section 34 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates the local government units to promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, Article 64 of the Implementing Rules and Regulation of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the procedure and guidelines for the selection of representatives of Civil Society Organizations ("CSOs") in the Local Special Bodies ("LSBs");

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government, through its Memorandum Circular No. 083-2022 (the "DILG MC"), provided guidelines for accreditation of CSOs and selection of representatives to the LSBs;

WHEREAS, item 3.11 of the DILG MC defined "Recognized Organization" as "an organization allowed by the sanggunian to participate in a local special body for purposes of meeting the minimum requirements of membership. An organization may only be recognized if it meets all the criteria except for registration.";

WHEREAS, the City Government of Pasig conducted a CSO Conference last August 5, 2022 for the purpose of orientation and subsequently, a call for accreditation was formally announced by the City Vice Mayor, Honorable Robert Vincent Jude B. Jaworski, Jr.;





COMMITTEE ON NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS

COMMITTEE REPORT

SUBJECT: Proposed Resolution No. 151-2023 entitled “A Resolution Recognizing The Civil Society Organizations In Pasig City For Their Participation In The Local Special Bodies, Committees, and Councils Pursuant To Department Of Interior And Local Government Circular No. 2022-083, And For Other Purposes;”

And

Proposed Resolution No. 152-2023 entitled “A Resolution Accrediting The Civil Society Organizations In Pasig City For Their Participation In The Local Special Bodies, Committees, and Councils Pursuant To Ordinance No. 43, Series Of 2017 And Department Of Interior And Local Government Circular No. 2022-083, And For Other Purposes.”

The Committee on Non-Government Organizations held its meeting on February 14, 2023 at around 3 o’ clock in the afternoon, to discuss the proposed Resolutions.

Present during the meeting were the Members of the Committee as follows: Councilors Quin A. Cruz, Mark Gil M. Delos Santos, Paul Roman C. Santiago. Also present were Councilor Raymund Francis S. Rustia.

Invited resource persons present were: Ms. Marianne B. Anceno of the Department of Interior and Local Government – Pasig City Field Office, Ms. Priscella Mejillano of City Planning and Development Office, Mr. Rechie Tugawin, Mr. Mario Galvez, Jr. and Ms. Carmina Labordo-Senogat of Office of the City Mayor – CSO Team.

The Civil Society Organizations (“CSOs”) Call for Accreditation Conference was held last August 5, 2022. The CSOs who attended the conference were provided with an orientation on the guidelines for LGU accreditation of CSOs, the avenues of CSO participation, and the importance of their participation in the local government.

After the recognition and accreditation of the Second Batch of CSOs by the City Government last October 2022, 271 new CSOs applied for recognition and/or accreditation; hence the need for this resolution.

A CSO may be qualified for accreditation provided that: (1) they comply with the requirements set forth in DILG Memorandum Circular No. 083-2022, and (2) their programs or projects have contributed to the goals of the City Government of Pasig. One of the important documentary requirements for CSO accreditation is a certificate issued by a national government agency proving the existence and legitimacy of their organization. If an organization has no such certificate, they can only be qualified as a “Recognized CSO”. If an organization has such certificate but lacks other requirements, the Office of the City Mayor will provide them with assistance to complete such requirements to qualify as an “Accredited CSO”. This is a clear effort on the part of the City Government to empower the CSOs to be accredited.

It was also clarified that CSOs who were not elected, whether “Accredited” or “Recognized”, may still manage to suggest or recommend programs to their respective local committee, council or body.

The Technical Working Group and Mayor’s Office – CSO Team conducted various activities empowering the CSOs and has been improving their CSO monitoring system and oversight function. The Committee commends the Office of the City Mayor – CSO Team and Technical Working Group for facilitating the entire process of accreditation and recognition of CSOs and their selection for LSBs. The Committee recognizes the important role of the people’s participation and involvement in the plans, program, projects, and activities of the Pasig City LGU, and in the delivery of public goods and services. As such, the Committee also recommends the following:



1. Amend the Title to add "Committees and Councils";
2. Encourage youth organizations to be accredited and recognized;
3. Provide assistance for CSOs by helping them to be accredited from being recognized only;
4. Participation of recognized and accredited CSOs in the procurement process provided that the procurement at hand is related to their LSB's discipline and advocacies;
5. Establish a CSO desk focal point system and assign a fixed Secretariat for the focal offices responsible for LSB, Committees, and Council and formalize their responsibility in a form of Executive Order or Sanggunian Resolution;
6. Strengthen the grievance and feedback mechanism for CSOs with disputes and conflicts;
7. Strengthen the partnership with CSOs and empower them to articulate their needs as they participate in the decision-making process, program planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation which can increase responsiveness and efficiency of the Local Government of Pasig in delivering services; and
8. Encouragement of CSOs to participate in legislation by attending committee hearings and Sangguniang Panlungsod sessions.




