COMMITTEE REPORT

The initial hearing was held on February 13, 2023 at the Session Gallery Hall, 7th Floor, Pasig City Hall in the presence of the majority members of the Committee on Appropriations, Ways and Means, together with Mr. Ramon Emmanuel Derige, Executive Director of Sea Oil Foundation Inc., Ms. Vikki Rose Bulacso, representative from Sea Oil Foundation, Inc., Ms. Rosevilla Ruales, representative from the Samahan ng Nagkakaisang Taga-Riverside Homeowners Association, Ms. Jenily Capalaran, City Nutrition Action Officer and Mr. Allendri B. Angeles from the City Environment and Natural Resources Office ; with the Proposed Resolution No. 165-2023: A Resolution Authorizing The Honorable City Mayor, Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto, To Enter Into And Sign A Memorandum Of Understanding Between The Local Government Unit Of Pasig City And SEOIL Foundation, Inc. And For Other Purposes referred to the Committee on Appropriations, Ways and Means during the Regular Session held on February 9, 2023.

After a careful study, the following resolutions were finalized:

1. As presented by Councilor Marion Rosalio Martires, the Proposed Resolution No. 165-2023: A Resolution Authorizing The Honorable City Mayor, Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto, To Enter Into And Sign A Memorandum Of Understanding Between The Local Government Unit Of Pasig City And SEOIL Foundation, Inc. And For Other Purposes
2. Ms. Vikki explains SEOIL Foundation's Tugon sa Gutom program started in 2021 with 23 families in Calongay, Sorsogon, now Tugon sa Gutom has reached 1000 families across 56 barangays all over the Philippines. For Tugon sa Gutom's implementation in Pasig, a 75 square-meter community farm in Brgy. Pinagbuhatan; where 23 participating families can plant crops or vegetables. In its pilot implementation, training and starter kits for those involved were disseminated. The harvests will be used for nutritional programs for children of families dealing with malnutrition and food insecurity.
3. Ms. Rosevilla explains challenges faced by the community during the pilot implementation included lack of security, cleanliness, and a lack of direct source of water.
4. Ms. Jenily Capalaran explained that Brgy. Pinagbuhatan has the top count of malnourished children.
