A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE VICTOR MA REGIS N. SOTTO TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY ALLOWANCE OF THE CHIEF PROBATION AND PAROLE OFFICER, SUPERVISING PROBATION AND PAROLE OFFICER, AND PROBATION AND PAROLE OFFICER UNDER THE PAROLE AND PROBATION OFFICE IN THE CITY OF PASIG, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, Section 458 (1)(xi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod may provide for additional allowances and other benefits to other national government officials stationed in or assigned to the city;

**WHEREAS**, the Parole and Probation Office, as an attached agency of the Parole and Probation Administration under the Department of Justice, is tasked with the correction and rehabilitation of criminal offenders who are under the probation or parole system;

**WHEREAS**, through Administrative Matter No. 18-03-16-SC dated April 10, 2018, the Supreme Court allowed the accused in drug cases to enter into plea bargaining agreements subject to its prescribed guidelines;

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the Supreme Court's issuance on plea bargaining there is an increasing number of cases being handled by the officers assigned at the Parole and Probation Office in the City of Pasig;

**WHEREAS**, in Resolution No. 7, Series of 2021, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Pasig granted a monthly allowance in the amount of Php1,000.00 to the Probation and Parole Officer, Php2,000.00 to the Supervising Probation and Parole Officer, and Php3,000.00 to the Chief Probation and Parole Officer under the Parole and Probation Office of the City of Pasig;

**WHEREAS**, the Parole and Probation Office of the City of Pasig is requesting for an increase in the monthly allowance of their officers all of whom tirelessly play a vital role in providing rehabilitation services to individuals under the parole and probation system of the city;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PASIG, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED**, to authorize the City Government of Pasig, through the Honorable City Mayor Victor Ma. Regis N. Sotto, to increase the monthly allowance of the officers under the Parole and Probation Office of the City of Pasig as follows:





Mr. Presiding Officer and Members of the 11<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod the Committee on Peace & Order, Human Rights, Judicial Matters and Anti-Drug Abuse respectfully presents & renders the Committee Report on the Committee hearing conducted last February 20, 2023 at the Gallery Hall of Session Hall, 7<sup>th</sup> floor Pasig City Hall.

### **The Committee Reports:**

Committee Chairperson delos Santos motioned to acknowledge the presence of the SPPO Perez and CPPO Aquino from the Probation & Parole Officers Office where they were given the floor to manifest their inputs in regard to the proposed Resolution that will increase their allowances.

SPPO Perez recounted that the agency lacks budget for rehabilitation. The agency usually taps other agencies and NGOs for budget provision. He also narrated that the group handles more or less 300-400 cases, but budget is so minimal thus they are seeking for financial assistance. Committee Chairperson delos Santos then inquired how many staff do they have in the office. SPPO Perez manifested that they are only 4 in the office, thus he requested for 4 individuals. The fourth member is under Job Order (JO). SPPO Perez raised his inquiry on why the list as shown in the proposed resolution is only 3. This was answered and confirmed by Committee Chairperson delos Santos & Vice Chair de Leon that JOs do not have the same benefits as the other employees thus his name was omitted in the list.

Since there was only 4 officers of the said office, Vice Chair de Leon applauded them for their hard work as she admits that their office is indeed under armed given that they are only 4 officers and they have more than 400 clients. This was seconded by Councilor Gonzales where he was once invited by the Probation & Parole Officer to attend an event where he personally saw the number of clients & the efforts of the few personnel of the office.

Chairperson delos Santos & Vice Chair de Leon then asked on how can the City Government help their office whereas it was manifested by SPPO Perez that the City can help through deployment of additional staff that can help them implement the programs of their office and allotment of open space for their rehabilitation activities as the current venues that they utilize is not enough for the number of clients they cater or the weather can hinder them since majority of the spaces are open space.

The committee members manifested their inputs where one of the places that they suggested and will look into is the RAVE Park, City Quadrangle, Tanghalang Pasigueño Garden and Pasig City Sports Complex. It was suggested by Councilor Syvel

Asilo that their office can try to communicate with the Liga ng mga Barangay as there might be venues offered by the Barangays that can add up with the choices for their activities.

In terms of rehabilitation and development of the clients of the Probation & Parole Office, Councilor Quin Cruz & Presiding Officer Pro Tempore Corazon Raymundo mentioned that they have programs that can help their clients such as the Out of School Youth (OSY) program and the Entrepreneurial program that can help the parolees.

Committee Chairperson delos Santos manifested that the committee can help the said office through future resolutions or ordinances that can be drafted that will help enhance the said suggestions from the members.

Committee Chairperson delos Santos moves to adopt the said resolution which he reiterated that the following proposed allowances of the Parole Officers from 2023 onwards will be as follows:

Chief Parole Officer- from P3,000.00 to P5,000.00

Supervising Parole Officer - from P2,000.00 to P3,000.00

Probation and Parole Officer - from P1,000.00 to P2,000.00

**Summary of Discussion:**

- There are only four (4) officers of the said Probation & Parole Office.
- Only 3 of the 4 officers were granted of additional allowance as one of the officers is classified under the plantilla of Job Order (JO).
- The plantilla of the officers is under the National Government thus the city can only give allowances.
- The committee was able to identify that 20% of the Parolees are female. And most of the parolees are 30 years and below.
- The probation & Parole Office & City Council will look for a venue that can help them implement their programs.

**Recommendations:**




